












Old rivalry revisited

It may have been simmering for nearly 30 years, but one of football's great rivalries from the past will be renewed this weekend when the AFL Victoria Community Cup is played at Simonds Stadium in Geelong.

For the first time since 1986, the best players from country Victoria will lock horns with the best players from metropolitan Melbourne clubs.

When the old foes last met at Bendigo's Queen Elizabeth Oval back in July 1986, Country emerged victorious.

The Country team contained some pretty talented players including current Port Adelaide coach Ken Hinkley, Geelong full forward Gavin Exell and ex Blue/Magpie and now Bendigo Pioneers Talent Manager Ray Byrne.

Exell and Hinkley kicked 15 goals between them as Country posted an 89-point win.

While it has taken a while for the Metro boys to be given a chance to avenge that performance, preparation has been heightened over the past four months towards today's game.

The Metro team, coached by ex-Western Bulldog great Brian Royal, was selected from the AFL Victoria Metro Championships between the six senior metro league's back in March at Visy Park.

Hawthorn legend Peter Knights will coach the AFL Victoria Worksafe Country team, which includes players from all across the state who competed in the Worksafe Country Championships back in late May.

The AFL Victoria Community Cup, a curtain raiser to the Peter Jackson VFL match between Geelong and Richmond, will showcase the best talent in community football in Victoria.

It's hoped the match will become an annual event on the Victorian football calendar.

Complementing the AFL Victoria Community Cup, the GrainCorp

AFL Victoria Country No.2 team will face a representative team from the Victorian Amateur Football Association's Premier B to Division 4 competitions.

And, the EnergySafe Victoria Country U19 team will tackle a U19 VAFA team. Both matches will be played at the St Albans Football Club ground in Geelong.

Congratulations must go to South Australia on its success in the recent NAB AFL Under 18 Championships.

While South Australia emerged with a deserved Championship title, it's worth noting that Victoria has the most number of players in the All Australian team, selected by an independent panel of seven, including AFL National talent Manager Kevin Sheehan.

Congratulations to Christian Petracca, Ed Vickers-Willis, Angus Brayshaw, Paul Ahern, Peter Wright, Darcy Moore, Jayden Laverde (Vic Metro) and Patrick McCartin, Caleb Marchbank, Darcy Tucker, Rhys Mathieson, Darcy Parish (Vic Country) for their selection in the All Australian team.

Christian Petracca from Eastern Ranges also won the Larke Medal for the best player in Division 1.

The NAB AFL Under 16 Championships have also just concluded on the Gold Coast. Well done and thanks to all the players, staff and volunteers who represented Vic Country and Vic Metro so well last week.

The talented player pathway in Victoria continues to maintain its strength.

SA win title after thrilling last round

South Australia has won back to back NAB AFL U18 Championship titles, with a nine point win over Vic Metro in the series finale at Simonds Stadium last Thursday.

In a thrilling contest, SA was able to hold off a late challenge by Metro to win 11.13 (79) to 10.10 (70).

Western Jets player Jayden Laverde was the best for Metro, with his move up forward paying off with three goals, 11 disposals and 3 marks.

Laverde along with Christian Petracca (Eastern Ranges) who finished 17 disposals did all they could in the second half to try and get Metro the title win, but SA were too good.

Dan Nielson (Eastern Ranges) in defence, Sandringham Dragons duo Harry Dear and Ed Vickers Willis and Sam Switkowski (Northern Knights) were also among the best for Metro.

Despite not winning the title, Metro did claim the Larke Medallists, with midfielder Christian Petracca named

the best Division 1 player at the Championships having averaged 25 disposals across his five games — with a high of 31 disposals against Vic Country in Round 3. Petracca also was awarded the Metro MVP.

In the earlier Round 6 match, Western Australia spoiled the title hopes of Vic Country with a thrilling come from behind win.

Vic Country held the lead for the majority of the game, but in a tight final term, WA kicked the only goal for the quarter which put them in front and they held on for a two point win. Finals score 10.5 (65) to 9.13 (67)

Lukas Webb (Gippsland Power) was the standout for Vic Country with 4 goals, 6 marks and 4 inside 50s.

Dan Butler (North Ballarat Rebels), Hugh Goddard (Geelong Falcons) and Rowan Marshall (North Ballarat Rebels) were also among the best, while Jordan Cunico (Gippsland Power - 16d), Rhys Mathieson (Geelong Falcons - 16d) and Nick Dixon (Geelong Falcons - 15d) led the disposals.

After exceptional performances across the championships, Jack Lonie (Dandenong Stingrays) was named the Vic Country MVP.

Victoria dominates All Australian selections

Twelve Victorian's have been selected in the 2014 NAB AFL U18 Championship All Australian team.

Vic Metro (7) and Vic Country (5) represent over half of the 22 selections made at the end of the Championship, with eight of AFL Victoria's TAC Cup clubs having a player named with All Australian honours.

The honour for these players is just reward for their achievements across the Championships in 2014, with each being a standout.

AFL National and International Talent Manager Kevin Sheehan said this year's championships were played to a

high standard and many players put their names forward for selection.

"Many of the players selected today will be named by clubs at the NAB AFL Draft in November," he said.

"Both Victorian teams played very well throughout the carnival and they have been rewarded with 12 All-Australian players. It was also very pleasing to see three players from New South Wales included."

"South Australia were outstanding winning Division One back-to-back. Theirs was a very even team performance and they were rewarded with four players selected."

Last year Victoria had eight players named in the All Australian team, with all eight drafted and having made their AFL debut this season including the likes of Jack Billings, Josh Kelly and Zak Jones.



Finals hopes hinge on injury prevention

Are your star players constantly missing games through injury and are your finals chances fading as a result?

The rapid rise of the Port Adelaide Football Club has been driven by many factors but the Power's fitness levels and injury management protocols have undoubtedly played a huge part in their revival.

Fitness guru Darren Burgess has been credited with developing arguably the AFL's fittest team and one that has suffered very few injuries.

Burgess' importance to the club was recently highlighted when he was re-signed to the end of 2018 on a significant remuneration package.

At community level, injuries to key players are often largely attributed to luck, and while the footy gods may have a role in determining whether your best players are on the park or watching from the sidelines, there are proven steps you can take to prevent injuries at your club.

1. Have trained personnel treat any injuries

It is important to ensure your club has qualified sports trainers or first aiders present for each match and training session. Getting good advice about injuries and knowing when to refer players to specialists can have a huge impact on number of games missed by your players.

To ensure your sports trainers and first aiders have the right skills and qualifications contact AFL Victoria or Sports Medicine Australia to find out more about upcoming course options.

2. Ensure all coaches are qualified

Appointing coaches with accreditation is now common place at most football clubs which delivers many benefits. By completing a Level 1 coaching course, coaches undertake a mandatory injury prevention module which helps their understanding of their important role they play in minimising the injuries at their club. They are also taught about the need to work closely with the club's head trainer to form an injury management partnership.

Clubs are encouraged to actively promote AFL coaching courses to

prospective coaches at the club which will then encounter an injury prevention module.

3. Ensure all participants are 'Fit to Play'

Do all players at your club do the right thing when injured? Do they undertake their injury rehabilitation following best practise? When suffering an injury during a match, do they go off the field for diagnosis and appropriate treatment?

And importantly, do they remain off the field when advised to do so, i.e. serious injury, suspected concussion?

The answers to these very important questions can often be directly correlated to the size of your club's injury list and the subsequent impact on club on field performance. In simple terms: injury prevention equals better performance.

It is crucial to consider participants' current and previous injury status as well as their foundation strength before deciding the best course of, and time-frame, for rehabilitation

For every injury a player receives, it becomes more difficult to return and the chance of re-injury increases dramatically.

It is also important to have clear guidelines on return to play, ensuring sports trainers, first aid officer, physiotherapist or doctor have the 'last word' or provide clearance to injured participants. The team coach should always respect their advice and never place a player back in to play if such advice

recommends against this.

The AFL FootyFirst program provides a number of exercises to build strength and prevent leg injuries in Australian football, and can be accessed by searching footy first in the AFL Community Club website search tool.

AFL Victoria is currently working with Sports Medicine Australia – Victorian Branch and Sport and Recreation Victoria to meet recommendations from the state government funded Sports Injury Prevention Taskforce.

This article is one small step amongst a range of initiatives that you will notice over the coming months that will be delivered as part of this partnership




