1. ANNOUNCEMENT:

The Keyneton Motorcycle Club, hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct the South Australian Moto Trials Championships at the Collingrove Hill Climb & Robert Broad's property on Hill Climb Road at Mount McKenzie on the September 6 & 7 2014.

2. JURISDICTION:

2.1. The abovementioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling SA Inc which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number C14119 and is open to holders of current Motorcycling Australia National Open Senior/Junior, Restricted National Licences, plus Recreation and One Event Licences.

2.2. The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. ENTRIES:

3.1. Entries open forthwith and close last mail **Tuesday, September 2nd, 2014**

3.2. Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.

3.3. Entries are to be sent to: SA Moto Trials Championships, PO Box 563 Angaston, SA, 5353

3.4. **NOTE:- LATE ENTRIES MAY RECEIVE A 20 POINT PENALTY. THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE KEYNETON MCC**

4. INSURANCE:

4.1. National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.

4.2. Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.

4.3. **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE.**

5. MEDICAL SERVICES:

To be in accordance with the Motorcycling SA Standards for 2014!

6. ENTRY FEES:

6.1. Solo \$70.00, Sidecar \$95.00, Junior \$40.00, Family rates; additional Adult \$60.00 each, additional Juniors \$25.00 each.

Non-Comp, Solo \$60.00, Sidecar \$75.00

6.2. Payment by Cash, Cheque or Money Order only

ANY FEES FOR DISHONOURD CHEQUES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT. If paying on the day is selected you may still be liable for the entry fee if you do not attend.

6.3. Cheques and Money Orders are to be made payable to the Keyneton Motorcycle Club Inc.

6.4. If requiring a **1 Event Rec Licence**, add **\$30.00** (per rider) to your entry fee, licence to be collected on the morning of the event.

6.5. **If requiring a Senior One Meeting National Licence, you will need to apply for one through Motorcycling South Australia at least 21 days prior to the event (Friday August 16th), For all enquiries contact the Motorcycling SA office, 8332 9000, administration@motorcyclingsa.org.au. This licence can be collected on the Saturday morning of the Championships at sign on!**

7. AWARDS:

Awards to placegetters in each class dependant on number of competitors.

Recreational and One Event Licence holders may ride any grade section for no awards.

8. ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

8.1 To constitute an **official Championship** class, the minimum number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be **FOUR (4)**, **EXCEPT THE FOLLOWING CLASSES, OPEN WOMEN, ALL JUNIOR AND SIDECAR CLASSES WHICH SHALL BE THREE (3)**.

8.2 Should there be insufficient entries in any class of competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine classes and re-distribute any awards, will be at the discretion of the promoter.

9. CLASSES OF COMPETITION:

Sidecar; A, B, Classic

Senior Solo; EXPERT, A, B, C, Veterans, Open Women, Historic Blue, Historic White, Clubman, Non-Comp (can be solo or sidecar)**

Junior Solo; Junior A, Junior B, Junior Women, Mini Trial**

Open and Junior Women will be able to nominate their regular split colour, with placings decided by the higher split; ie; those riding red, then yellow, blue, white and run of section.

Veterans has been re-instated for the SA Championships, but will only be a single class and will ride to blue splits.

The Historics will ride as two separate classes, subject to 4 entries in each – Blue ride to blue splits, White ride to white splits
 B Grade Sidecar to ride Yellow/Black splits, Classic Sidecars have run of section.

A 'Classic' sidecar shall be defined as having an air-cooled motor and drum brakes, with no sidecar wheel brake.

If there are less than the required 3 entries in B Grade & Classic Sidecars, they will run as a combined class – as per regular SA events

** Mini Trial is designed for entry level riders and requires a small wheeled, automatic gearboxed bike and is a **non-competitive** class.

** Non-Comp riders is a **non-competitive** class and competitors ride for **NO Awards**

10. RIDING FORMAT:

10.1 The Trial will be an ALL DAY RIDE, run under "TRIALS" rules.

11. MACHINES AND RIDERS:

11.1. All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for Moto-Trials competition.

11.2. Machines and competitors must report to machine examination during times shown in the Time Table and produce their MA licence. There is a penalty for lateness, 1 point per minute as per GCR's, penalty shall not apply if you are in line to be examined at time cut off.

11.3. No bikes are to be ridden before machine examination.

11.4. Bikes may be ridden and maintenance done in the competitor's car park area, BUT AT A WALKING PACE ONLY.

However, refuelling is only allowed in the designated refuelling area and the use of an enviromat is required.

Penalties apply for failure to observe these rules, maximum 100 points or exclusion.

11.5. Riders must present their scorecard to the scorer at the completion of each lap (Penalty for each unattempted section is 5 points)

11.6. Substitution of Motorcycle may be allowed, subject to the approval of the Clerk Of Course or Steward.

11.7. Officials may ride as and when required to perform their duty.

12. NAME PLATES:

12.1. All bikes will have name plates which MUST comply with the GCR's.

12.2. **Historic Blue to ride with BLUE plates, Historic White with WHITE plates, as per their split colours**

12.3. **Junior A to have an 'A' clearly on their name plate, Junior B to have a 'B', Mini Trial to have an 'M', Non Comps to have an 'N'**

This is for the ease of the observers and to avoid confusion between white line and open section, competitive and Non Comp riders

13. RIDERS' BRIEFING:

A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of riding, which ALL competitors MUST attend.

14. DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

14.1. All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA and MSA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency and the Motorcycling SA Drug and Alcohol Policy.

14.2. If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, tel 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prizemoney may be delayed at the Motorcycling SA Inc. discretion until the results of the tests are known.

15. CODE OF CONDUCT:

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia by-law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCRs), which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.
