#### ON SITE CAMPING

With the facilities available at the hill climb, camping is more than welcome; it is encouraged, with full toilet facilities and flat ground all through the pit area for all campers!

Camping will be available on Friday and Saturday nights only (not Sunday sorry) and will cost \$10.00 per family, in caravan or tent, with proceeds going to the Sporting Car Club to help with the upkeep and maintenance of the venue.

The camp fee can be pre-paid with entries, with an area to tick on the entry form.

### **CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES!**

A full range of classes will be available for the Championships, including Veterans, but all classes will need to receive the minimum entries to be classed as an official SA Championship, as per Motorcycling SA's requirements. \*\*To constitute an official Championship class, the minimum number of contestants entered and competing in each class shall be FOUR (4), EXCEPT THE FOLLOWING CLASSES, OPEN WOMEN, ALL JUNIOR AND SIDECAR CLASSES WHICH SHALL BE THREE (3).

#### Senior solo:

EXPERT, A, B, C, Veterans, Clubperson, Historic Blue, Historic White, Open Women Junior solo;

Junior A, Junior B, Junior Women Sidecars; A Grade, B Grade, Classic

\*\* Open Women AND Junior Women will be able to nominate their <u>regular</u> split colour, with placings decided by the higher split; ie; those riding red, then yellow, blue, white and run of section.

The regular non-competitive classes, Mini Trial and Non-Comp, will also be available for all those who are either, too young to hold a competition license, or would just like to have a ride and be a part of the Championships.
