3 Jayden GEE - Strong half back/mid fielder. Has had a very solid season.


Daniel BATTAGLIN - Gives away size but takes on the power forwards each week.

Joshua DODSWORTH - Plays tall and has great running ability.



5 Mathew FLETCHER - Finally gets another grand final chance after missing last year. Been wrapped in cotton wool all year so ready to explode.






Anthony VELLA - With a raking left foot and an endurance to run all day, Vel can get the footy in long and direct to give our forwards the first option.
