

BRAVE EFFORT TO THE END

U15'S DO OUR CLUB PROUD DESPITE GOING DOWN



In a high quality game of junior football, Hill Top Under 15's came up just short in the 2014 HSA decider, going down 3-1 to minor premiers Bundanoon at East Bowral. The Kookaburra's overcame the early loss of William Harris (hamstring strain) to share the early honours with the Rebels, with Samuel Johnson strong in defence repelling a number of dangerous attacking raids. A tightly fought contest was blown wide apart in the 28th minute when Zac Bishop burst through the Bundanoon defence to put away a wonderful mid-range strike, sending the large Hill Top supporter group (who were truly magnificent!) into raptures. The contest remained very tight as the game approached half-time, when a foul against Emma Rumble presented Bundanoon with a long-range free kick opportunity. A beautiful strike by Bundanoon gave them a share of the lead going into the half, with Kookaburra's goalkeeper Mathew Bates the unfortunate victim of a wicked bounce that found the back of the net. The Kookaburra's came very close to registering a 2nd goal in the opening stages of the second half before Bundanoon stole back the initiative - their striker beating Matthew Bates to the ball by the barest of margins in putting away their second to stun the Hill Top faithful. Bundanoon's third goal came 25 minutes into the 2nd half courtesy of a powerful mid-range strike, however, despite the obvious disappointment, Hill Top remained strong throughout the contest, continuing to press Bundanoon's defence at every opportunity. Hill Top went very close to bringing up their second goal when the Bundanoon 'Keeper denied a long-range rocket from Samuel Johnson – a shot that would have been a contender for goal of the year. U15's coach Mark Johnson was full of praise for his team, who's efforts on the day were a proud reflection of the team's hard work & dedication over the course of the entire season. The Kookaburra's had excellent contributions across the entire park in the grand final, with Zac Bishop, Michael Shute & Samuel Johnson all strong in the field, & Mathew Bates making many tough saves in a highly polished goalkeeping display. Despite the result it was a day our club could be extremely proud.


