Proposal Notice of Annual General Meeting

Aim The Constitution states that the Annual General Meeting is required to be advertised in the local paper, the current practice is that the Annual General Meeting is advertised on the Mid West Football League's website and clubs are emailed the notice of meeting. The Constitution needs to be updated to reflect current times.

Current:

20. NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The time and place of the Annual General Meeting of the League shall be notified in the local press, and shall be given to members of the League and to Secretaries of Clubs, and such notices shall be given at least 14 days prior to the date of the holding of such meeting.

Suggested change to:

20. NOTICE OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The time and place of the Annual General Meeting shall be set by the League Executive. Notice of such meeting shall be issued to members of the League and the Secretaries of Clubs via email or post, along with posting on the Leagues public website. Such notices shall be sent at least (fourteen) 14 days prior to the date of the holding of such a meeting.
