Friday 31st – Thursday 6th

This week is a critical week for all players named in the **Provisional** 2015 Breaker teams on Friday 24th October. Provisional selection will only become Permanent upon payment of a Registration fee. Deadline: 9.30pm Friday 31st October.

The timeline to Permanency is very much determined by the player rule involved with the VJBL Practice Game 1 on Friday 7th November.

Breaker teams nominated for the VJBL practice game 1 on Friday November 7th will form the teams for Phase 1 of VJBL grading. No player movements can happen after this game.

Committee of Management [COM] Selection Guidelines

MDBA is a club of limited resources [3 courts] yet fast growing in player numbers in its Domestic competition. As a local community club the COM wanted to provide a "priority pathway" for the children of MDBA members. To facilitate this the following selection guideline steps were implemented:

- 1. Players had to be of Breaker Representative standard. This standard determined by the Coaching Director and the Independent Assessment Panel.
- 2. MDBA player: A player currently playing Domestic or who played the Breakers 2014 Season qualified for priority selection.
- 3. For each age group the number of teams multiplied by the number of players in each team = Total number of player positions available.
- 4. MDBA players given priority placement. Remaining vacancies offered to new players.

Some age groups, most notably the Boys U14 and U16, had more players, both MDBA qualified and new, than positions available.

The end result is 5 MDBA players and 12 new players from other clubs missed out. This is a very small number given over 440 players started the Try Out process. Over 50 new players got in.

There will be 36 Representative Breaker teams for Season 2015. This is an increase of 4 teams on 2014.

For the 2016 Breaker season Try Outs will most likely be closed with all players being "MDBA qualified". It will certainly simplify the process and significantly reduce the time involved.

This "closed" approach should not be interpreted that MDBA has no commitment to success. This could not be further from the truth. There is an absolute drive to provide the best program for both our players and coaches. We are happy for the scoreboard to be the judge. The biggest drive for success lies in training - skill development and intensity being the keys.

Registration Deadline – Friday 31st October

Players named on Friday 24th October in Breaker's 2015 teams have Provisional status. "Provisional" will ONLY becomes "Permanent" upon a Registration payment. Deadline: THIS Friday 31st October

Insurance

Registration fees provide for extensive insurance cover under an arrangement with Basketball Victoria. It covers players, coaches, trainers, referees, voluntary workers, committee members and employees for professional indemnity, public liability and personal accident.

The scope of personal accident covers competition, training, social functions, committee meetings and fundraising and travel to and from these activities. Further information is available via the website link at the end of this document.

The registration fee also covers court hire, training sessions and payments to the VJBL and are generally not refundable.

Additional Costs

Other than the registration fees and the travel costs, for VJBL sanctioned games each team is required to pay the venue they play in a fee for the team-sheet and there is usually an accompanying door entry fee ranging from \$2.50-\$3.00 per person including players and spectators. Teams manage their own costs and will typically charge each player about \$10 per game to cover the team-sheet fees and other incidentals.

Game Times

Matches are played on Friday nights with U12s scheduled early in the evening around 6:40pm through to 9:50pm for U18 and U20's. Players are typically required 30 minutes prior to game start time. Allow 50 minutes for the game.
