We're really excited about what we are going to be able to offer you with **Stadium Scoring**

The A grade women, playing in our Tuesday night women's comp. have been the pioneers for an anticipated transition to **Stadium Scoring** across CHBA competitions.

If you haven't heard of **Stadium Scoring**, it is a tablet/laptop based computer program that does away with the paper scoresheet and at the same time captures and displays a much broader depth of game information than our paper based systems allow.

Stadium Scoring has been developed by Fox Sports Pulse the company which provides our competition management software and our website and accordingly **Stadium Scoring** integrates smoothly with our competition management and results service.

Here is a screen dump from our competition management system in our existing **Greenhouse Tavern A Reserve men's comp.** This display is accessed via the "draws and results" tab on the top menu.

Were you to select the "season stats" from the menu above the results – you would find the display empty!

When you press on one of the teams in the display – let's try Team Praan this is what you

will see;

A summary of recent results for Team Praan, details of their next game and a collapsed version of the points table in their division.

Contrast this with the information now available in our **Greenhouse Tavern A grade women's competition** because they are using **Stadium Scoring**.

Here is the screen dump from the Greenhouse Tavern A grade women's competition:

Results display is the same as with the men, but look what happens when we click on a team, say "Hoops I did it"

Now, as well as displaying the results of their last 5 games, we are able to see the cumulative points for all members of the team, their average points per game, how many games they have played and the number of fouls for each player.

If we click on the "season stats" tab above the game results we are linked to a display which shows statistical leaders across a number of categories for the whole of the division.

You can see that in the season so far **Eleanor Hewitt** is the leading scorer with 39 points, **Jordan Woods** leads the count from beyond the 3 point arc, and **Jordan** also is the leading free throw shooter.

Looks like **Bailey Garrels** despite her

However there's a really good video on *YouTube* which should make you feel comfortable with the point and touch method of keeping scores in your game.



Stadium Scoring Action Guide

1. Turn on console
2. Click on 'STADIUM SCORING' shortcut
3. Enter 'RUN DOWNLOADED GAMES'
4. Start game and continue to run following instructions below.



1. **Start Game/ Run Clock:** Used to mark the start of game as well as to start and stop the clock
2. **Change Team Colour:** Change team uniform colour
3. **Edit Game Clock:** If the clock is stopped time can be edited by double clicking
4. **+1, +2, +3:** Used for free throw makes, 2pts, 3pts
5. **Foul:** Allocating fouls; Technical fouls appear in brackets next to total fouls
6. **Timeout:** Keeps track of remaining timeouts. When clicked a timeout deducted from the total
7. **Team Stats Allocation:** Used for allocating bench technical fouls and points left unallocated
8. **Active Players:** Used to select team members playing in the current game
9. **Add Players:** Add a player not yet allocated to the team
10. **Change Numbers:** If a player is wearing a different number to normal it can be changed here
11. **Edit Scores/Fouls:** Used when actions are incorrect allocated if more than one action ago
12. **Undo Last:** Undoes the LAST action. (If more than one action back use edit scores/fouls)
13. **Report Injury: (REFEREE ONLY)** For reporting injured players and assistance given
14. **Report Incident: (REFEREE ONLY)** For reporting players for tribunal offences
15. **Confirm Game: (REFEREE ONLY)** To confirm the final score is correct
