Q & A

Q When will the new Association commence?
A Incorporation date will be 1 January 2015 or as soon after as practicable

Q Will I have to pay money to the new Association (SCBA)?
A Yes, however your current BQ insurance will be honoured by SCBA. Game fees will only be paid to SCBA for competitions run by the Association.

Q Will I still be able to play game at my club venue/s?
A Yes, SCBA hope to use all current venues for the interclub competition. In regards to domestic/club games, this will be decided on whether there is a need from SCBA and the Clubs when the Board is appointed.

Q What is "interclub" competition?
A You play for your club against other clubs in the association. You will have a chance to play in the inaugural "Sunshine Coast Basketball Cup" !!!!! – Whose club will be victors – will it be yours?

Q When will the interclub competition commence?
A Interclub will commence for juniors in 2015 and seniors in 2016.

Q Will I be able to play in my current Rep Team?
A No, representative players will be representing Sunshine Coast Basketball. Players will be chosen from all Clubs. Representative trials will be held for these teams. With over 2000 members, SCBA will have the ability to field representative teams in all divisions.

Q What about QBL and SBL?
A The Suncoast Clippers QBL teams will be transferred to SCBA in 2016. There is the ability to have SBL teams from the Association (Div 1) and the Clubs (Div 2) depending on the wishes of the Clubs and players.

Q Who will run the association?
A The Board will be made up of an appointed member from each of representative Club. The management committee will employ suitably qualified administrator/s to attend to the business of the association.

Q I play for Rip/ Clippers/ Rebels/ Cyclones – who will I be playing for?
A You will still play for your Club team in the inter-club competitions. At Association representative level you will be playing for the yet unnamed Sunshine Coast team. The steering committee will be recommending to the new board that a "Name my Team" competition be held amongst members to come up with an exciting name for our exciting new association's rep teams.

Q How will the Association be funded in its initial stages?
A Basketball Queensland will fund setup and legal costs of the new association. Each association will be asked to make some financial contribution, in an equitable manner, as determined by the board
