2015 Player Registration

HJFC is implementing an online player registration for 2015.

The process will be as follows:

- Late January an email will be sent to all existing members and those from Auskick that fill in Expression of Interest forms with the login information.
- Use the login information to update information and register the player for the 2015 season following the prompts.

If you have multiple players, you will be able to register them at the same time.

Fees payment will not be availa-

ble through this system due to the administration costs associated.

The online registration process will reduce the amount rework required at the start of the season in checking all the paper copies against the AFL Players database.

The medical forms and Code of Conduct will also be part of the registration process.

As with any changeover there will be some problems initially as we get the hang of things, but please bear with us as we try to reduce the work load of the registrations officer and team managers into the future.

The Yarra Valley Commission put forward a proposal to change the U18 and U16 competitions to U19 and U17 going forward which would have changed the core age groups in the DRJFL also.
