- Any teams with unpaid fees at the completion of the season will have the entire amount split equally between ALL players on the nomination form. Each player will be required to pay this amount prior to them being eligible to play or transfer in future competitions.
- For a player to be eligible for finals, they must be on the team nomination form. Additions or Deletions to players on the nomination form can be done using the Additions/Deletions form available from the web-site or the office.
- The entire season fee may be invoiced at your request prior to the start of the competition. Invoices will be issued at the first game, and will be payable IN FULL within 14 days (Round 3). If the invoice is not paid IN FULL by this time, the team may be removed from the competition.
- All players must be registered prior to taking the court. Unregistered players will be unable to play. If a team is found to have played an unregistered player, or a player under an assumed name, they will be assessed an Unregistered/Assumed Player Penalty.

IMPORTANT CHANGES TO THIS SEASON

Each team is required to provide 1 representative for scorebench duty for any game in which they play. Where either team is unable to provide a representative for the scorebench, a member of that team shall, undertake this requirement unless this results in the team being left with three or less players to participate in the game. In this instance, the team will be assessed a No Scorer Penalty.

Wagga Wagga Basketball Association Senior Competition Rules Summary

AUTUMN 2015 COMPETITION – 14 ROUNDS PLUS FINALS

- The competition will be run according to WWBA Competition By-Laws. (Copies available on the web-site or from the office)
- By participating in WWBA Competitions, all participants agree to abide by the Codes-Of-Conduct. (Copies available on the web-site or from the office)
- Players must play a minimum of 51% of the minor rounds to participate in the finals. A competition BYE or opposition forfeit counts as having played.
- A competition BYE or opposition forfeit will be awarded as a win, with 3 ladder points and a score of 20 to 0
- Teams must have a minimum of 4 eligible players on court at the scheduled starting time, if this is not the case, a penalty of 2 points per minute or part thereof will be added to the opposition score.
- Players may play in more than one consecutive division, i.e. Div 1 & 2, or Div 2 & 3 but not Div 1 & Div 3, or State League & Div 2 etc. Players may not play for more than one team in any given division. Teams will still be subject to normal grading criteria. Junior players are exempt.
- An 'Un-notified Forfeit' is declared if the game is not started within 10 minutes of the scheduled time.
- A forfeit must be advised to, and acknowledged by, the office on 0447 663 925 at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled starting time to be deemed a 'Notified Forfeit', otherwise it shall be deemed as an 'Un-notified Forfeit'.
- Three forfeits (Notified or Un-notified) may result in removal from the competition
- Players must be in uniform after round three of the competition. Players not in uniform will be permitted to play, however a 5 point penalty will be added to the opposition score for each player out of uniform.
