



## Parent/Player information Sheet

This information is provided for parents of children interested in team selection for NCFNC for 2014.

NCFNC is part of the larger Geelong Football Netball League. This league is a high standard and extremely competitive across both football and netball. We will field teams in both the Saturday Divisions and the Friday night competitions at Kardinia Park.

As a club, NCFNC is committed to providing opportunities for all persons to play netball in a safe, inclusive and supportive environment. We are committed to the development of all junior netballers. As a club we aim to do this by encouraging each and every individual to play at a level appropriate to their ability. As such, players may not be placed in teams based on where their friends are playing, or times or days they are available.

We aim to help your child reach their full potential as a netballer by increasing their netball knowledge and skills while working together to promote teamwork, discipline and respect. As a result we will attempt to place your child in a team that is most likely to offer development and success for them as an individual and as a team.

### Trial Information:

- All players to wear a white top and black/blue shorts
- Please bring a water bottle

### Trial and team selection process:

- **Players must return their registration form by closing date as trial rotations will be determined by our Senior Coaching staff prior to the day to ensure players all get court time in nominated positions**
- All players to nominate their 2 preferred positions
  - All players will receive at least 1 trial in each nominated position
  - All players will have at least 2 trials per session
  - Please note that late registration means we cannot guarantee trialing in both preferred positions at the first trial.
  - Players may be asked to trial in a position other than nominated if the selection panel feels this is appropriate.
- Teams are selected with the following in mind:
  - Skill, ability to play at the appropriate level
  - Potential for coaching
  - Number of players nominating for a position
  - Balance of team (shooters, midcourters and defenders) not just the 7-9 strongest players
