CODE OF CONDUCT

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT:

Play for the fun and friendship that sports provides, not to please parents or coaches.

Play by the rules at all times and be a good sport.

Winning will be achieved as a direct result of working hard at improving your skills.

Do not expect to win all the time.

Play for enjoyment and the challenge of improving.

Treat all players and opponents with respect.

Learn the rules of the game and respect the umpires and officials that organise it.

Avoid using derogatory language/ swearing towards players and officials. Such action is not acceptable.

Respect your club and the environment in which they provide for you to play.

Follow team rules and never argue with officials (umpires, coaches and team managers).

Co- operate with your coach, team mates and opponents.

Use of Social Media, including but not exclusively Face book, Twitter, Big Footy etc. you are not to use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability – as this is illegal.

CODES OF CONDUCT FOR PARENTS /GUARDIANS AND SPECTATORS:

Encourage children to participate according to the rules and support them at all times.

Teach that HONEST EFFORT IS THE VICTORY, NOT THE WINNING.

Be prepared to get out of the car at training and match days, get involved and offer assistance if needed.

Never abuse the opposition or the umpires, always set the example for your child to follow. Remember that opposition officials are also giving of their time.

Recognise the value of volunteer coaches and assist by giving time to provide an opportunity for your child. Support the coach and assist by giving your child positive reinforcement.

Avoid living out your expectations through your child, let them develop at their own pace and enjoy themselves.

Remind your children that winning is not as important as developing discipline and skills and that all they should give is their best effort.

Consider that children play sport for the fun and not for the entertainment of the spectators. Remember they are not professionals.

Take a genuine interest in the club that your child plays for. They are providing an environment that will assist young people obtain positive life skills.

Parents do not help a player by confronting the coach on his selection policy or undermining his position. If you disagree with an official, raise the issue through the appropriate channels rather than questioning the officials judgement and honesty in public.

Encourage the fun aspect in sport. Let your child enjoy the opportunity to spend time with friends.
