GREEN SHIRT UMPIRE RULES

KEY POINTS FOR INTRODUCING NEW UMPIRES TO THE LEAGUE.

Ensure all new umpires have a Mentor Umpire to assist with their introduction to on-field umpiring.

Ensure all new umpires are mentored in accordance with the AFL Green Shirt Mentoring Program, particularly in regards to their progression through to higher levels.

Ensure all new umpires commence umpiring in the LOWEST age group possible.

Ensure all new umpires commence in accordance with the following:

Umpires must be at least 14 years of age.

Umpires must do the Level "O" Umpires course in their first year.

14 Years of Age & Above – Commence at LOWEST age group possible and progress to higher levels as competency improves.

Progression to a higher level is at the discretion of the Umpires Director, Umpires Coach and the Umpires Mentors.

Green Shirt Umpires may umpire at a higher level with two (2) Senior Umpires (Orange Shirt Umpires) for the purpose of evaluating their competency to umpire at that level.

No Green Shirt Umpire will act as a Central Umpire in finals.

Green Shirt Umpires may act as Goal Umpires or Boundary Umpires in finals.
