The wavy lines represent the wide expanses of water that surround Northland, Auckland and the Waikato, including the Waikato River, while the mountains evoke the Waitakere Ranges, Bombay Hills and Kaimai Ranges, as well as the numerous volcanoes that are scattered throughout the area.

The Harbour Bridge connects Auckland's southern suburbs with the North Shore and stands proud in the distance of the logo while the history of the competition is reflected in the slogan '50 Years of Local Pride'.

Wanderers will provide a stern test though as Mark Cossey's men enjoyed an impressive campaign in 2014 to finish just a point off second spot.

Central United vs Three Kings United

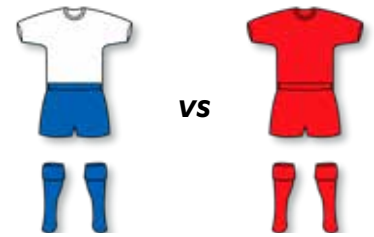

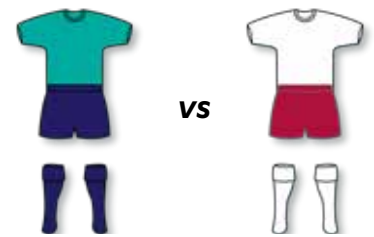

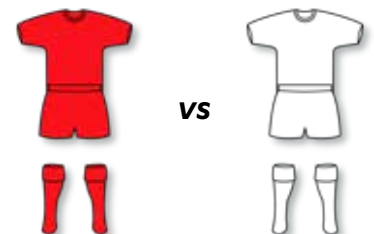

Forrest Hill-Milford United vs Waiuku

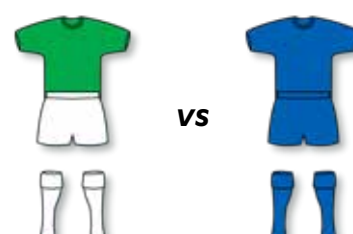

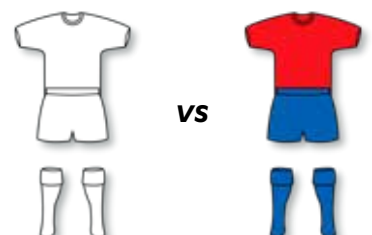
