Senior Coach's Report

Following on from what was a successful 2014 Season with having both the Seniors & Reserves in the 2014 Grand Final, and mixed emotions by having the Reserves claim the premiership with the Seniors pondering what could have been, our focus was on the 2015 season to go one step better. Our recruiting was focussed on installing midfielders who were able to kick goals and adding outside run and pace to our side. Former Bundoora utility Robbie Graham joined the Mustangs along with Memo and the fab four from the bush in Judd Darby, Ben Ryan, and Luke Walsh & Kane Reid, which built up our midfield stocks.

Our coaching staff changed slightly in 2015, with John Fraser being appointed as the reserves coach who joined Gabriel Sebeh, Toby O'Meara & Michael Mannix as the Senior Assistants.

After an extremely slow start to the preseason number wise, and the start of the season we found ourselves 1-3 after the first four rounds and struggling to get a settled side due to unavailability's and injuries, slowly we started to regain the somewhat form of 2014 by winning the next 3- games which seen us move into the Top 4.

Following our first bye we succumbed to South Morang losing by 25 points, however the scoreboard was no reflection of our performance, the following week we were lucky to win against St Marys by a solitary point, but as a group the most disappointing loss came in Round 11 against Banyule which was the turning point of the year. We were able to build the momentum and won the next (6) home and away games by on average on 42 points to move into 2nd spot and were rewarded with the double chance.

Our first final against South Morang started slowly however 6 goals to 0 in the 3rd quarter allowed us to open up the game and move into our 2nd Grand Final in successive years, winning by 42 Points. The lead up to the Grand Final was quite nerve racking for all involved especially waiting on who our opponent was to be, finally we were able to focus as we faced Epping in the last game of the year.

Again a slow start to the game, our 2nd quarter lead by Judd Darby, Toby O'Meara and Ben Ryan seen us kick 8 goals to 2 to lead by 25 points at the main break from there we increased our lead in each quarter to finally win our 1st Senior Premiership in 31 Years.

In 2015, we played (35) Players in the Seniors, with Kent Beaumont enjoying his best year kicking 33 Goals in which he played all 18 Games through the year. Kelsey Clayton, Marc Defelice and Kael Beaumont who were the younger and quicker brigade in our side all playing a huge part in the Grand Final success.

There are quite a few people that I would like to thank personally for the efforts of getting the players on the field and the relentless nature that you provided around the club.
