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AFC Under 18's Coach Position Description

Overview of Role:

The role of the coach is to manage the on-field performance of the club's Division 2 team and develop the players that come in and out of this team. The role will also provide leadership within the football department and the club as a whole, assisting the other club coaches as required.

- General Manager

Other Reports:

- Football Administration Manager

Responsibilities:

- Responsible for the coordination of pre season and regular season training
- Attend all training and team sessions
- Oversee team selection in liaison
- Liaise with medical staff with regards to the rehabilitation/ availability of injured players
- Provide regular feedback to players individually and as a group
- Develop the role of individual players within the team in liaison with Senior Club Coach
- Implement the game plan in liaison with Senior Club Coach
- Provide input into list management
- Prepare the Under 18 team for match days
- Liaise with support staff in preparation for match day
- Oversee the coaching of the Under 18 team on match day
- Attend any courses, information nights, meetings designated by AFC
- Represent the Club where requested at official function, events and initiatives
- Adhere to the Club and AFL Canberra 'Code of Conduct'
