Founded in 2009, the Preston Bullants Amateur Football Club (PBAFC) (formerly known as the Northern Bullants Amateurs (2009-10) and the Northern Blues Amateurs (2011-15) competes in Division 2 of the Victorian Amateur Football Association (VAFA).

We are based at W.R. Ruthven Reserve, Corner Albert Street & Malpas Street, Preston. The Club represents the fast growing northern corridor of Melbourne, offering people living in the area a chance to play for and support an amateur football team.

In the years prior to senior inception in 2013, the Club fielded an U18 Division 1 team in the VAFA in 2009-10 and an under 19's team in Division 3 in 2011 before fielding a team in the U19's Division 3 and Premier B Thirds competition in 2012.

The PBAFC has a strong culture aimed at providing the opportunity for young footballers to play with their friends in a safe, competitive and social environment.
