- 1. 2014 Chairman's Report (Narelle Smith)
  - a. Full report is available online at <a href="www.sawfl.org.au">www.sawfl.org.au</a> Amongst other things, the affiliation with the SAAFL has resulted in:
  - b. The appointment of Caitlin Brady in the role of Club Development Officer at the SAAFL who performs the administrator role for the SAWFL. This role was filled with the help of SAAFL CEO John Kernahan and we thank him for his support.
  - c. Better tribunal system and support for the SAWFL.



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- d. Under 16 Girls Competition this had it challenges but finished off with an enjoyable Knockout Competition. Next year we come in line with AFL age requirements and this competition will instead be an Under 15 Girls Competition with a similar format.
- e. Summer Training Squad started off small, links in with SANFL's talent programs, engages with girls throughout summer so that we don't lose them to other sports and allows them to work on their football all year round. It is an important link, to develop to the standard required for 2020 AFL National Women's Competition.
- f. Women Supporting Women Program looking to introduce this in 2015 in order to encourage people within the League to celebrate the success of all SAWFL members.
- g. Thank you to Julie Wells and Jamie Thomas who have worked hard all year on the SAWFL Board.
- 2. 2014 Treasurer's Report & Financial Statements (Julie Wells)
  - a. Referring to the Income & Expenditure Statement (available at <u>www.sawfl.org.au</u>), the main income and expenditure items were:

  - c. As part of the partnership between the SAWFL & SAAFL, the SAAFL collected the Affiliation Fees from SAWFL Clubs in 2014. They received a total of \$26,302.10 ex. GST in call fees, which contributed to funding the following SAWFL related expenses:
    - i. Tragedy Insurance for all teams \$8,931
    - ii. SAWFL Presentation Night Pre-Paid Tickets \$10,800
    - iii. And the remainder of \$4,180 which was received as an Admin Fee contributed to:
      - Venue hire for SAWFL clubs throughout the year and the SAWFL finals.
      - Free sausage sizzle and chips for participants of the Under 16 Girls Knockout Competition
      - Contribution toward the employment of a paid SAWFL administrator within the SAAFL.

The SAWFL has for many years talked about implementing a player points system and we feel it is time to bring something in that is appropriate and we will be implementing rules around the number of player transfers permitted between SAWFL Clubs each season. After consultation with the SAAFL and a review of the results from the SAWFL Members' Survey, the League will be implementing the following rules as soon as possible. We wanted to present these rules at the AGM given the majority of key people within clubs are in attendance. Please take these rules back to your club and discuss with your members and provide any feedback to The League prior to COB this Friday 19th December.



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- 9.5 A Member Club of The League is not permitted to accept the transfer of more than five players from other Member Clubs of The League during the period of 1st October to 30th September in any year.
- 9.6 A Member Club of The League is not permitted to accept the transfer of more than two players from any one Member Club of The League during the period of 1st October to 30th September in any year.
- 9.7 Exemptions to Sections 9.5 and 9.6 may apply in special circumstances or in the case of hardship, which shall be directed to The League in writing. Such application for exemption will be either accepted or denied by The League at its discretion.
