2015 Coaching Reaccreditation Policy/ Procedure



Policy

As part of the AFL's Accreditation Program, all accreditation courses conducted in Victoria will follow this "Coaching Reaccreditation Policy" consistent with other states and recognised by the Australian Coaching Council.

When a coach is seeking reaccreditation this Policy must be practised for consistency and accountability regardless of the level at which the coach is seeking reaccreditation.

Requirements

Level 1 Coaches

The <u>onus is on the coach</u> to maintain his/her accreditation and to keep a record which will need to be presented to the relevant AFL Victoria Development Manager on application for consideration for reaccreditation.

During the four year period, the coach will be required to fulfil the following requirements:

- 1. Actively involved in coaching as part of a coaching team or working individually for the length of the four year accreditation period.**
- 2. Must be a member of the Australian Football Coaches Association for the term of the accreditation.

NOTE: A coach who has not coached for **one of the four years of his/her accreditation period due to factors which the AFL Victoria Development Manager and/or the State Director of Coaching consider legitimate reasons (i.e. work, family, health reasons) may still receive reaccreditation, provided that the coach has maintained his/her membership of the AFCA in that year).

Any coach who has not coached for at least three out of the four years of his/her accreditation period is not eligible for reaccreditation unless it can be demonstrated that valid extenuating circumstances have precluded him/her from doing so. The State Director of Coaching will make this ruling.

The coach will need to verify his coaching record by producing proof from office bearer of the club(s) he has coached at.

If the coach has been found to have broken the AFL's Code of Conduct or any League/Association's (affiliated with AFL Victoria) Code and has been disciplined for such actions, reaccreditation applications should be directed to the State Director of Coaching for approval.

Procedure

When a coach receives confirmation of his/her accreditation, the "updating clock" starts. This is indicated by the date shown on the Accreditation Certificate.

For level 1 Coaches, proof needs to be supplied to their relevant Regional Development Manager in the form of a letter of service from the club(s) or school(s) that coach has served.

The Development Manager then cross-references the applicant's claim of AFCA membership for the Four-year period.

Prior to acceptance of Reaccreditation, the Development Manager needs to have applicant sign the AFL Code of Conduct and undergo AFL Vic Screening/Check procedure

The cheque and details of the successful applicant are forwarded to the State Director of coaching to process centrally.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH REACCREDITATION PROCEDURE:

Coaches who do not complete the updating requirements as specified will be removed from the AFL's Coaches Register and will not be recognised as an Accredited coach.

This removal from the AFL's register may also contravene local league/association Coach Accreditation Policies precluding the coach from registering as a coach in that body.
