- create laminated A3 Code of Conduct sheets (Players, Coaches, Officials), REMEMBER YOUR CODE OF CONDUCT
- add Coach Code of Conduct to new Coach ID card

PRE-SEASON TRAINING

We are aware that some clubs have commenced pre-season training. Please note that players must be registered for 2016 to be covered for insurance and those players training that are NOT registered are training at their OWN risk. New players training with your club are also not covered for insurance unless a completed Permission to Train has been sent to us.

Please note a player who was last registered with another AFLBJ is not permitted to train with another AFLBJ until 7 days have passed after a Permission to Train form has been sent to us – the penalty for a breach of this rule could be \$500 per player if it can be proven.

Junior eligible players in 2016 that wish to train with senior teams during pre-season MUST also complete a Permission to Train form.

ON FIELD APPAREL

The 2016 AFL Queensland Preferred Suppliers list was provided in the Conference Booklet, all on field apparel MUST be order from one of these suppliers. With 2016 being the 150th year of football in Queensland a special logo has been created. This logo has been given to the preferred suppliers and they have been told to add it to any on field apparel orders for the 2016 season.
