## Purpose of the position

## Responsibilities & duties

- Contribute to the development and implementation of the 2016 Coaching Plan
- In consultation with the Umpire Coach, develop and implement the Trainee Umpire Induction Program
- Attend weekly umpire training sessions
- Execute the coaching plan to assist all umpires when required.
- Observe umpires and provide written observation notes
- Ensure umpires are observed to obtain their Level 1 Umpire Accreditation
- Remain up to date with current Laws of the Game and interpretations set by the AFL, and AFLBJ Rules and Regulations
- Conduct a minimum of 2 Junior Football Umpire Program training sessions.
- Act as a match day contact
- · Assist the AFLBJ Board of Management and Staff with finals and events as required
- Attend meetings when required.
- Participate in the AFL Umpire Coach Professional Development Program.
- Conduct end of season reviews as required
- Provide an end of season report to the State Junior Football Manager
