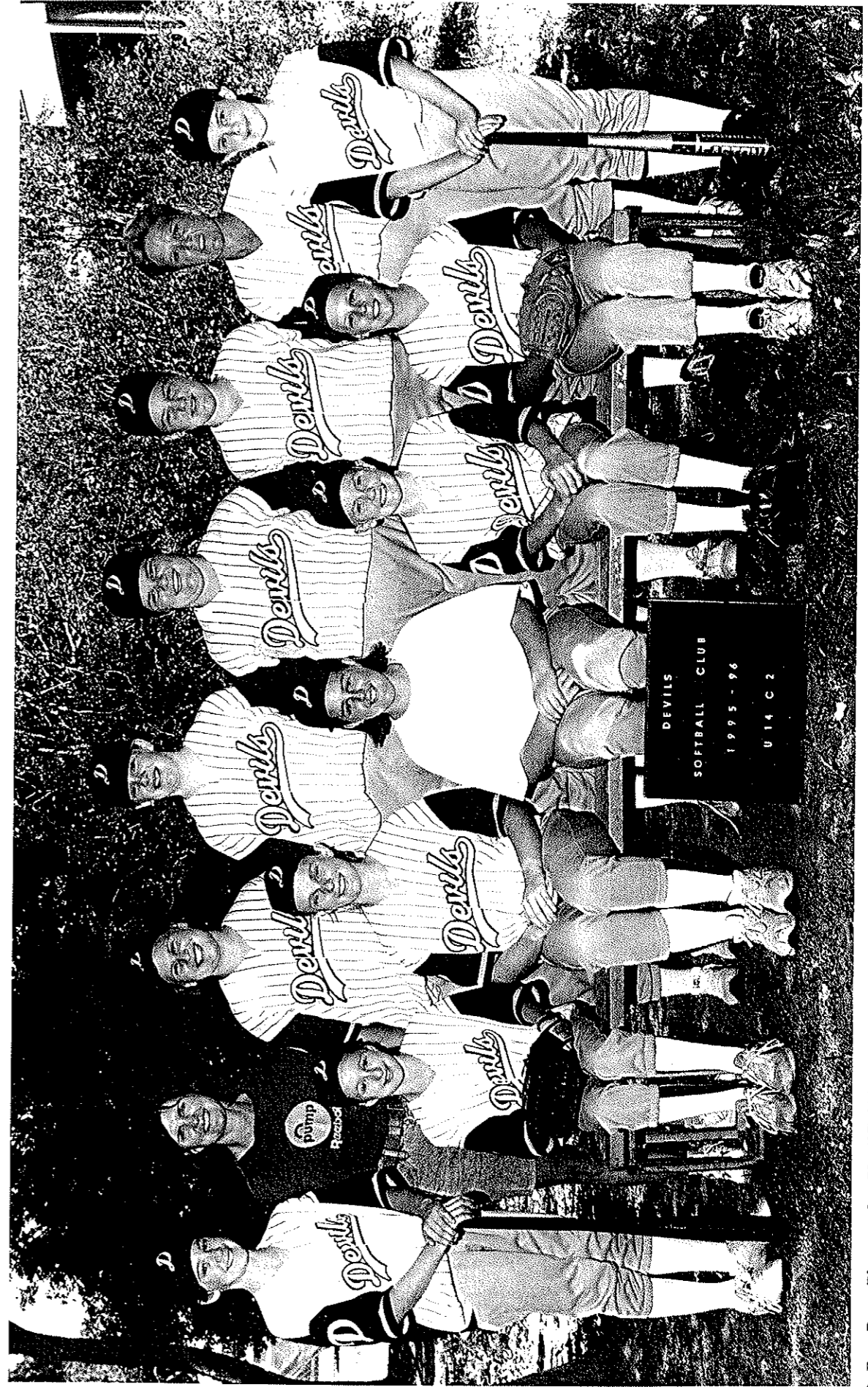
I cannot finish off without saying my final thanks goes to the people who make it possible to coach juniors such as this one, and that is your the parents, thankyou for your valued support.

Another player who has started club ball for the first time this year. Plays second base and after the initial settling period has got a good understanding of the plays. Must work on body behind ball and extended arms when batting.

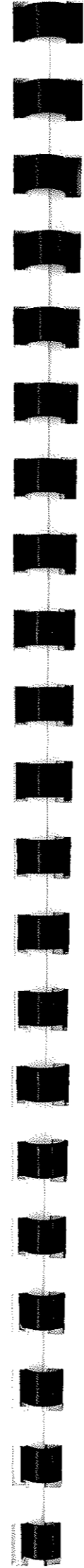
Stephanie Templeman:

A Devils player for the last two seasons. Plays catcher for the team and has really put in some hard work on throwing long distances. Keep up the good work Stephanie.

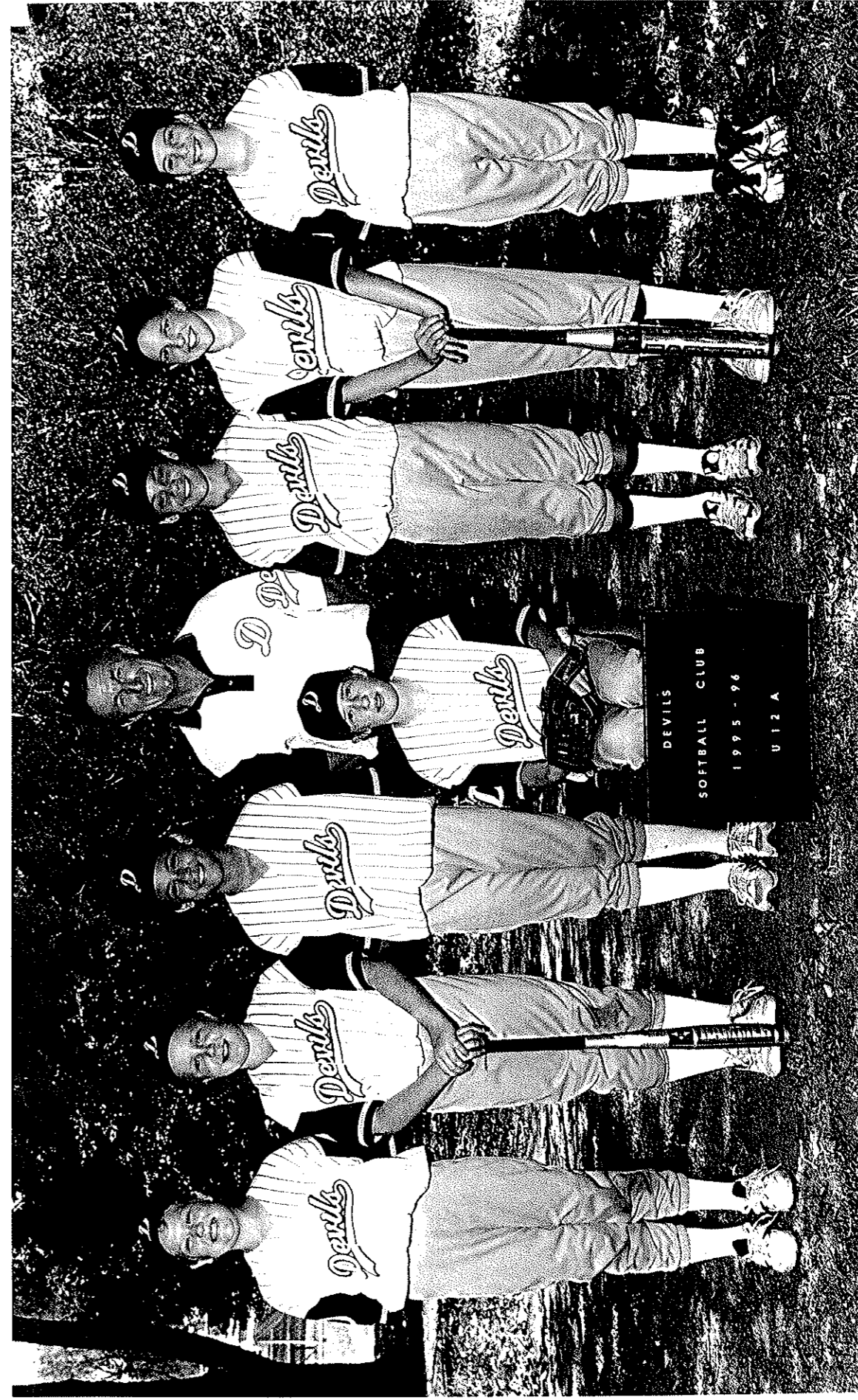
