About Chiltern FNC



The Chiltern Football Netball Club is a proud club with a history of success in the Chiltern and District Football League/Association (12 senior football premierships 1912-1953) and the Ovens and King Football League (10 senior football premiership 1954-2002).

At the completion of the 2002 O&KFL season, the club's members voted in overwhelming favour to join the strong Tallangatta & District Football League the following season. This has been an excellent move for Chiltern in many aspects, although silverware has been tough to come by.

After 13 seasons competing in the TDFL our senior football side has played finals in six of those seasons, including and 2006 grand final appearance and more recently featuring in the 2012, 2014 and 2015 finals series. During this time we have put in place plans to improve our on and off field professionalism, recruit the right people, and develop a club atmosphere that players and their family's want to be around and can enjoy. Evidence of this hard work paying off has been seen in our excellent track record in player retention, this focus has us well positioned with the introduction of the Player Point System across AFL Vic leagues in 2016.

At the end of the 2013 season the Netball Club and Football Club merged into the one entity, now known as Chiltern Football Netball Club. This has resulted in a renewed energy and focus of the entire club, a collective approach to decision making and also widened the audience for our sponsors with a greater membership base.

In 2015 our club had some 110 registered footballers from U14s through to the senior list, 100 netballers from Midgets to A Grade, over 250 paid up members, a very loyal supporter base and some great partnerships with our sponsors.

Senior Football



In 2014, former Wodonga Raiders champion, Mark Doolan joined us on a three year contract with both the club and Mark clear in their desire to pursue success, starting with a long term commitment from Mark sending a message of certainty to the playing group. Chiltern's list was growing in stature at the time and we felt Mark had the characteristics required of a leader that could take the list and the entire club to the next level. He has brought with him a fantastic work ethic and clear vision for our playing group and in 2015 (in his first season of a two year senior coaching role) improvement was clearly evident as the playing group quickly adapted to an exciting game plan which ultimately proved itself to stack up against quality opposition at Sandy Creek where we were able to kick 130+ points in our first two finals to record our first finals wins since 2006. This was an outstanding result for the club and Mark was recognised for his efforts by winning the 2015 AFL North East Border Coach of the Year award in September.

Mark has re-signed the majority of our 2015 senior list and expects minimal departures from his side that played three finals last season and made the preliminary final. We also welcome four confirmed signings in Dale Lappin (Midfeilder - DMB), Mitch Paton (Ruckman - Wodonga Bulldogs), Ben Harding (Key Back - Wodonga Bulldogs), and Jayden Quinlivan (Utility - Walla) and have a number of other players training with us and likely to join us before the start of the season.

2016 presents an opportunity for our club to push for finals once again and the challenge is certainly there for this group to pursue a maiden TDFL senior premiership. We would love for you to be part of the ride as a member and a partner of the club in 2016.



Junior Football

At Chiltern we have two junior football teams (3rds and 4ths) as well as a locally run Auskick program. The TDFL has a very strong junior program which has been one of the benefits of joining this competition.

In 2015 we played 3 eligible third's players in our senior side with Chris Anderson, Robert Phibbs, and Banjo Rogers all playing regular senior football throughout the season. We hope to continue to bring our kids on and keep playing them on their performances in the thirds, promoting them where possible.

Netball

Chiltern has 6 netball teams ranging from midgets through to Open Age (A, B & C Grade). In 2015 our club's 15&U, B Grade and A Grade teams all played off in grand finals, with B Grade winning the premiership. Our netball teams are coached by some excellent people and our club is welcoming of new players.

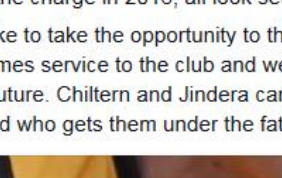

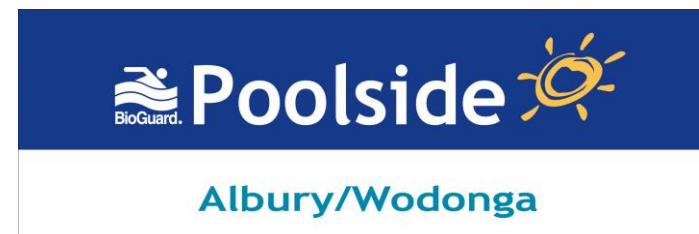
