COMMUNITY FOOTBALL LEAGUE CENTRAL REGIONAL FOOTBALL COORDINATOR'S REPORT – Todd

Level 1 Coaching Course

There have been significant changes in relation to the Level 1 Coaching Course.

The course will now consist of 3 components – online general principles of coaching course, a face-to-face coach education session and an assessment.

The face to face education session for the BLGFA is on Tuesday 24th March from 6pm – 9.30pm & will be held at Trinity College in Gawler.

Please note that registration & payment & the relevant online course need to be completed before attending the face to face education session.

The cost of the Level 1 Coaching Course is still \$160. On successful completion of the course clubs can apply for a subsidy for a proportion of the cost of the course under the CFL Education Subsidy program.

Please remember that all coaches need to gain their Level 1 Coaching Accreditation prior to or during their 2nd season of coaching.

Sports Vouchers

The Office of Recreation & Sport in South Australia is coordinating a \$50 Sports Voucher program to all Primary School aged kids. The Voucher is to be used by kids towards the costs of subscriptions at sporting clubs.

By now all Primary School aged kids should have received their letter from the OR&S in relation to the Sports Voucher program. To be able to accept these \$50 vouchers your club needs to be registered as a sports provider on the Sports Vouchers website.

Once your club has registered as a sports provider you can start accepting these vouchers.
