COMMUNITY FOOTBALL LEAGUE CENTRAL REGIONAL FOOTBALL COORDINATOR'S REPORT

Level 1 Coaching Course

There have been significant changes in relation to the Level 1 Coaching Course. In metropolitan areas including the BLGFA the course is now facilitated by the SANFL & not the SANFL clubs (e.g.CDFC).

The course will now consist of 3 components – online general principles of coaching course, face-to-face coach education session and an assessment.

The course for the BLGFA is on Tuesday 24th March from 6pm – 9.30pm & will be held at Trinity College in Gawler.

The cost of the Level 1 Coaching Course is still \$160. On successful completion of the course clubs can apply for a subsidy for a proportion of the cost of the course under the BHP Billiton Subsidy program through the Community Football League.

Please remember that all coaches need to gain their Level 1 Coaching Accreditation prior to or during their 2nd season of coaching.

Sports Vouchers

Community Football & the SANFL are in the process of finalising information and the process for the Governments Sports Voucher program and how it will work within the National Footyweb registration system.

At this stage we ask clubs to register their Clubs with the Office of Recreation and Sport. This will enable them to claim the \$50 back from Government. This can be done via www.sportsvouchers.sa.gov.au

Auskick

Auskick will again be up & running during the 2015 season in the BLGFA.

This season the cost of the program is \$60. Kids will be able to use their Government issued \$50 Sports Voucher for a proportion of this cost.

Over the next couple of weeks I will be contacting each coordinator from last season & seeing if they are going on or not.

Thank you to all of the clubs for your support of this program.

I will get from the executive of the Junior Delegates a copy of an email & a phone contact for each club & I will include these people in information I forward to the senior clubs. I have found previously that sometimes the information does not get passed down to a club's junior representatives & to alleviate this I will forward information to both areas.

If anyone needs my contact details please see me after the meeting & I will give you one of my cards.

Police Checks

I have passed out to each club a copy of my records in relation to their club's Police Check history.

All of those people listed in red had their Police Checks originated in 2012. Due to the 3 year expiry on the Police Clearance Certificates, if these people still have a role with junior players they will need to complete the Police Check process again.

Also please note that if a person has the 'Sighted by AO column' (last column) blank then I have not sighted the applicant's original Police Clearance Certificate.

Please remember that all Junior Coaches, Team Managers, Runners, Trainers & anyone who has the potential to be one on one with one of your Junior Players at your football club needs to undertake the Police Check process.
