U13 fencers Minimum:

350NW fencing jacket, 350N under plastron, glove, mask, fencing breeches (800NW or 350NW) and long socks. Chest protectors must be worn by girls in all weapons. Chest protectors must be worn by boys doing epee.

* Please note these are the minimum requirements, fencers may choose to wear 800NW garments if they wish. ** Electric bib masks will not be mandatory in any age group, although fencers may choose to use them.

\$30.00 for the day, including clinic and up to 2 competition entries
