### **Round 1 of the State Road Race Championship fires into action this weekend.**

After the recent exciting announcement regarding the partnership between the major South Australian Road Racing Clubs, the result being a newly formed series which will see the South Australian Championship (State Titles) run across 3 separate rounds this year. With this all set to kick off this weekend with round 1 being held by the Mount Gambier Motorcycling Club at Mac Park in Mt Gambier.

In what is an exciting time for the road racing community this is the first step of a unified resurgence to see the discipline gain momentum and push for further prominence in the motorsport community.

Round 1 will see the incorporation of the Mac Park Easter Cup. Practice/Qualifying from 9am Saturday with racing to commence at around 1pm. Sunday - Racing to start around 10am after a short warm up session. Classes include - 600cc, over 600cc, 20th Century, 20th Century +, Limited, BEARS & Juniors. Again this year the Club will be running the Easter Cup Feature Race in conjunction with the first leg of the Master of Mac Park with the points tallied from the first leg at Easter with the points from the second leg at the October Master of Mac Park meeting to give a winner with the highest points score over the two meetings.

The management and committee from Mac Park should be commended for the continual improvements being conducted at the venue. With this exciting new state series and some even bigger events on the horizon for the picturesque little venue, road racing in the area is in a great position. With Motorcycling Australia being involved in recent times, overseeing a lot of the improvements and advising of compliance and standards the entire process has been a professional success.

The management of Motorcycling South Australia has been passionate about supporting the clubs with putting this series together and think this could be the start of something special for road racing here in S.A.
