CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

When you registered your child to play AFL this season you agreed that both you and your child would follow the player and parental codes of behaviour. These codes are put in place to ensure all people that attend an AFL game have an enjoyable experience. Please read the codes of behaviour and discuss them with your children prior to the first game. Please remember our umpires are also children and respect their decisions at all times.

Players

- Play by the rules.
- Never argue with an official. If you disagree, discuss the matter with your coach after the game.
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, or deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent is not acceptable or permitted.
- Work equally hard for yourself and/or for your team. Your team's performance will benefit and so will you.
- Be a good sport. Applaud all good plays whether they be by your team or the opposition.
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated. Do not interfere with, bully or take unfair advantage of another player.
- Co-operate with your coach, umpire, team mates and opponents. Without them there would be no competition.
- Play for the fun of it, and not just to please parents/guardians and coaches.

Parents

- Remember that children play sport for their enjoyment not yours
- Encourage children to participate, do not force them.
- Focus on the child's efforts and performance rather than winning or losing.
- Encourage children to always participate according to the rules.
- Never ridicule or yell at a child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- Remember that children learn best by example. Applaud good play by all teams.
- Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from sporting activities.
- Respect official's decisions and teach children likewise
- Show appreciation of volunteer coaches, officials and administrators. Without them your child could not participate.
- The consumption of alcohol and smoking is inappropriate at all junior games.
