Family Day / Players Auction

Our Players Auction is a fun way for members, sponsors, supporters and community groups to have a closer involvement with the Kangaroos playing list 2016.

You can participate as an individual, or form a syndicate where one member will be the official bidder. Bidders must be registered on the day of the event through Rhianne Lewis.

By purchasing a players lot you will be eligible to receive a weekly cash dividend. The dividend will depend on the level of money in the pool.

80% of the funds raised will go towards the prize pool and 20% will contribute to the running of the day's event.

Each week 'Best on Ground' is allocated the following for each grade. Open Division Netball - 23%, Senior Football - 23%, Division One Netball - 18%, Reserves Football -18% Division two Netball - 18%

These percentages are of the weekly dividend allocated after the auction, according to the prize pool at the end. So the larger the pool, the higher the dividends!!

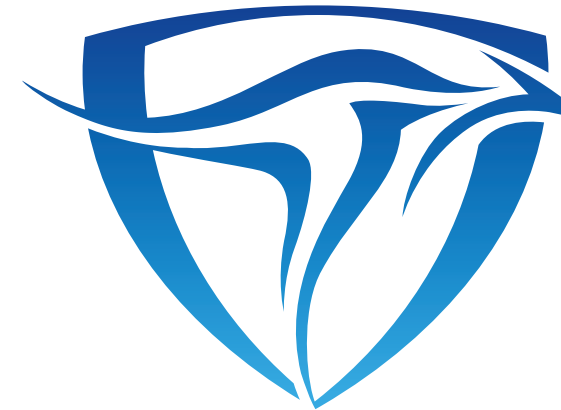

Matt’s background

Matt grew up in Hamilton, and began his football career playing with St. Marys in the Hamilton Junior Football League advancing through the under 14s and under 16s. Matt also represented Monivae College in inter school football, before progressing onto the Western Border Under Eighteen ranks with Hamilton Imperials in 1993, playing approximately 340 games including the Senior Premiership in 2001, before retiring in 2011.

Matt Dunn’s coaching experience stretches back to 1998 & 99 when he coached St. Marys under 14s Imperials Under 18s in 2000 then St.Marys-Monivae under 16s in 2002, Joint Under 18s coach in 2004-2006, Imperials Reserves coach 2009&2010. Senior Playing Coach at Coleraine 2012 - 2014 guiding Coleraine to the 2013 Premiership in that same year Matt was named South West Region ‘Coach of the Year’

From 2004 onwards ‘Dunny’ has been involved with the South West Region Under 15’s and was also North Ballarat Rebels Regional Under 18s Coach in 2015.

Kelsey’s background

“I commenced playing at the age of ten. From that point I played all my junior netball with the Hamilton Netball Club, as well as being part of many squads, academy programs and state development teams. I also played VNL with Eastside for two seasons in Melbourne. During my time at Hamilton I was given the opportunity to play three years of senior netball and fortunate enough to be part of Hamilton’s first ever A Grade Premiership team at the age Eighteen. Following that I transferred to Penshurst, playing there for five years in which time I was again thrilled to be part of four A Grade Premierships, including The Penshurst Netball Club’s inaugural A Grade flag.

My coaching career started at that club with Under 17s, before moving up to senior ranks with the C Grade team. I love coaching. Growing I had some of the best coaches in the district so I know how important it is for junior players to have good coaching right from the start of their development.

Last season I was appointed coach of the Kangaroos 13&under team, they were a fantastic bunch of girls to coach, every single one of them gave 100% each time they played. It is very pleasing to retain many of those girls again this season in 15&under.

Unfortunately this season I will be on the sidelines as a player due to being pregnant, but it will be a pleasure to watch both senior and junior girls step up to the challenge of competing at A Grade level. This group are eager to learn; and I know they will go out every week and do the very best they can”
