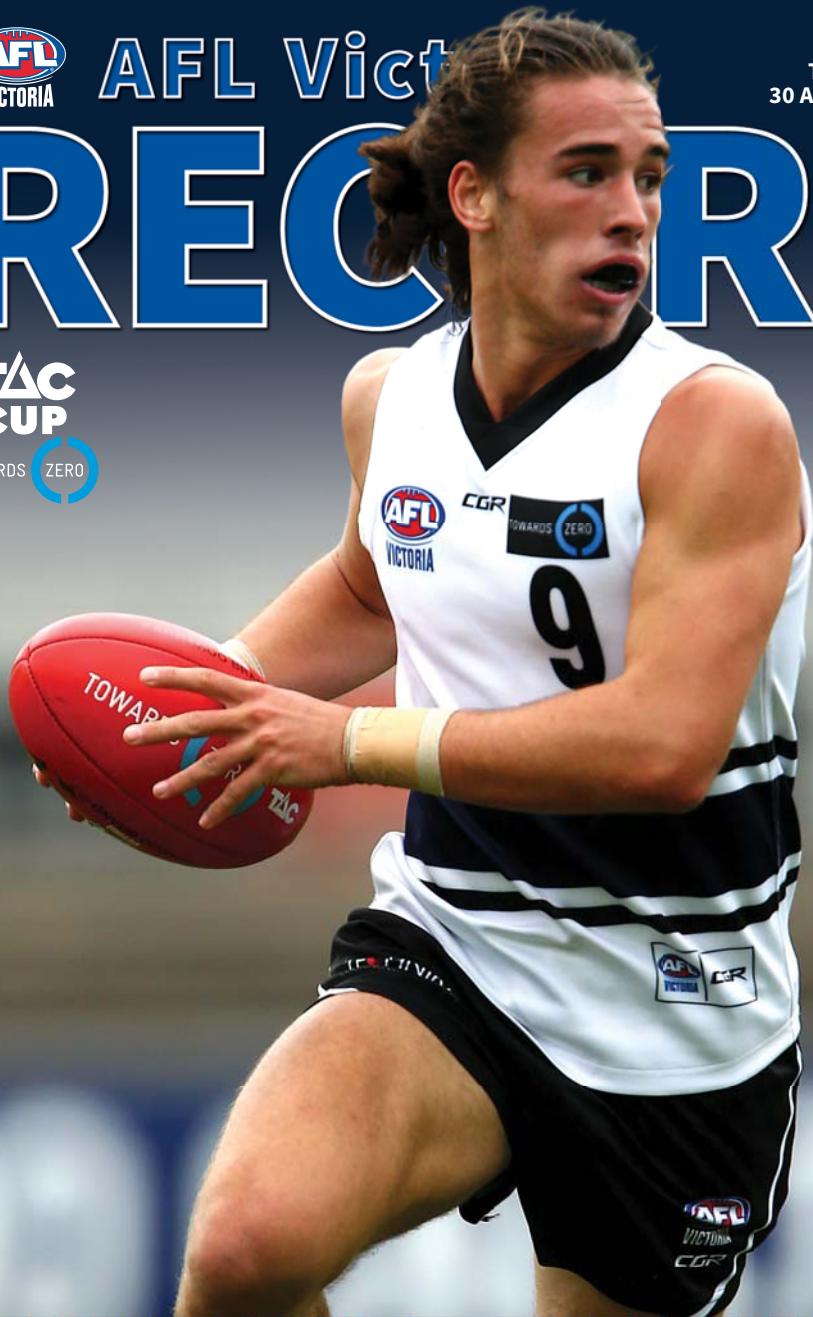

VFL an international training ground

We often look at the role the Peter Jackson VFL plays in the development of VFL-listed players.

There have been a number of success stories, with 42 players drafted over the last five years including names such as Adam Saad (Coburg/Gold Coast), Kane Lambert (Williamstown/Richmond), Dean Towers (North Ballarat/Sydney), Ben Brown (Werribee/North Melbourne) and Tory Dickson (Bendigo/Western Bulldogs).

One area of development that can often be overlooked is that of the AFL-listed players in the competition.

A prime example of this development is American-born Collingwood player Mason Cox who, after 21 games in the VFL, made his AFL debut in front of 80,000 fans at the MCG on ANZAC Day. For a player that had never heard of the AFL less than two years ago, it is a major achievement to progress so quickly to an AFL debut. Credit must go to the Collingwood coaching staff that has worked with Cox to help him reach his first game at the elite level.

We would hope the high standard of football he has been exposed to each week at VFL level over the last 12 months has aided his development, like a number of other international rookie players in recent years. Over the last two years we have seen the likes of Cox, Kurt Heatherley (Hawthorn/Box Hill Hawks), Jason Holmes (St Kilda/Sandringham) and Conor McKenna (Essendon/Essendon VFL), along with the new crop in Pdraig Lucey (Geelong/Geelong VFL) and Matthew Korcheck (Carlton/Northern Blues) develop their game at VFL level with the aim of forging an AFL career.

The role VFL clubs and the competition as a whole play in this development should not be forgotten when players like Cox debut on the main stage.

Ainsworth aims to meet expectations



TAC Cup players who excel in their bottom-age years don't have the luxury of playing in their draft year without the weight of expectation on them - Gippsland Power captain Ben Ainsworth is one such player.

After showing how much damage he can do as a small forward in 2015, AFL recruiters told the 18-year-old he should use 2016 to develop aspects of his game people haven't yet seen.

The first aspect of his game Ainsworth has sought to address this year is his leadership ability. The Morwell junior skippered U10, U12, U14 and U16 teams in his younger years but recruiters wanted to see him do it at the elite under-age level.

So he put his hand up for the Gippsland captaincy.

"I've always wanted to step up into a leadership role and take it upon myself to guide a few of the youngsters, because we have a pretty young side this year," Ainsworth said.

"I had it in the back of my mind because a few of the recruiters wanted to see my leadership skill and mindset this year. I took it upon myself in pre-season to become a bit more vocal around the group and give indications to the young people coming in to the club."

Ainsworth said he was naturally more of a leader by example on the field than a rousing pre-match speech-maker – "I always stutter under pressure," he laughs.

He certainly demonstrated his ability to inspire by his actions in Round 1, tallying 22 disposals, seven tackles, seven inside-50s, six clearances and kicking 2.2 in a loss to the Dandenong Stingrays.

The AFL Academy member did so even after

sustaining a cork in the area around his knee that subsequently affected his performance in one of the Academy's recent matches against VFL opposition and has kept him sidelined since.

Fortunately, Ainsworth doesn't expect the niggle to prevent him from representing Vic Country at the NAB AFL U18 Championships in June. He first announced himself to the football world at last year's Championships, booting 15 goals in six games for the undefeated Country team and earning selection in the U18 All Australian forward line.

It's fair to say Ainsworth will be more closely scrutinised in this year's Championships than he was in 2015.

"I just went out there last year and played freely I guess," Ainsworth said.

"I only played a few TAC Cup games early on and then had a few trial matches for Vic Country, and obviously I got in the side and made the most of it.

"There's a great deal of expectation this year but I'm trying to ignore that, and just playing footy is my main goal. The (Gippsland) captaincy's sort of taken it off my mind briefly but there's still a bit of expectation you got into games with."

The other aspect of his game recruiters are expecting Ainsworth to develop in 2016 is his ability to play through the midfield.

His performance against the Stingrays five weeks ago showed how dangerous he can be as an on-baller who also goes forward, and Ainsworth thinks he'll perform the same role for Vic Country at the U18 Championships.

"Everyone wants to see me in the midfield," he said.

"I know a few of the recruiters have challenged me with that and I'm looking forward to the challenge. I know I can play there, it's just displaying it.

"I've taken it upon myself to get around the right people who have been there and done that. I've been involved with (Geelong's) Patrick Dangerfield and (Essendon's) Matty Stokes (through the AFL Academy program) – pretty experienced heads. I'm trying to get as much information in terms of structure and stuff like that to better my game in the midfield."

The Academy has also worked with Port Adelaide star Robbie Gray, who the 179cm Ainsworth said was a good model for his own game based on their

similar heights and Gray's ability both in the middle and in front of goal.

While it can be difficult to escape the weight of expectation, Ainsworth can take comfort in the recent AFL Draft success stories of 2015 TAC Cup players such as Darcy Parish, Darcy Tucker and Rhys Mathieson, who starred in their bottom-age years and carried on with it as 18-year-olds.

He can also look to fellow Gippsland native and former forward-line teammate Tom Papley, who has made an instant impact for Sydney in 2016 after being selected in last year's Rookie Draft.

Despite the Power's winless start to the season, Ainsworth said Papley's success gave him hope for his own prospects in football: "It's just great to see someone from down here get the opportunity and the possibilities that are available to get up into the big league."

By taking on the challenges of developing his leadership skills and ability to play through the midfield, Ainsworth is giving himself every chance of meeting expectations and making the big league too.

Russell, leader of the pups



Footscray captain Jordan Russell is relishing the chance to share his broad range of football experiences with the young guns of one of the AFL's hottest clubs.

Russell, 29, played 116 games for Carlton from 2005-12 and nine for Collingwood in 2013 as a medium-sized defender. He joined Footscray in 2014 after the Magpies delisted him and is currently combining his captaincy role with that of a full-time development coach for the Western Bulldogs.

"I think I have a really good knowledge of all the highs and lows of AFL footy," Russell said.

"I had a whole range of experiences, from moving interstate to playing 100 games to being injured to being on the top of your game to being dropped and getting delisted.

"I think over the past six or seven years of my footy career I've tended to head towards the younger guys and tried to mentor them off the back of my AFL career going down the drain a little bit. It was a bit of a natural reaction to get away from my form when I was at AFL level and it sort of continued on into the VFL."

Russell's primary task is to fast-track the development of the Bulldogs' first to third-year AFL-listed players and have them ready to step up into senior coach Luke Beveridge's high-octane outfit.

He's currently working closely with Zaine Cordy, Josh Prudden and Roarke Smith, three young defenders Russell was "absolutely rapt" to see break through for two, four and one AFL game(s) respectively last year.

However, with Prudden injuring his ACL in the VFL two weeks ago and Smith sidelined by his own ACL injury since August, Russell has realised the benefit of his dual role as both their teammate and development coach.

"I want to make sure they're going OK and have regular chats with them – not just about footy stuff," Russell said. "They might seem like they're OK on the surface but there are often times they might go home in this period when no one's with them and they might be struggling.

"Because I've been playing with them, I feel like we have a relationship built and mutual respect there already, so you can potentially break down any walls that a player-to-coach relationship might have because it's also player-to-player."

As for his own playing career, Russell notched his 100th senior VFL game in Round 1 after a 2015 season in which he was named in the VFL Team of the Year back line.

The no.9 pick in the 2004 AFL Draft now seems on top of things, both on and off the field.

He'll be hoping Footscray's wealth of young AFL and VFL-listed talent can carry the club to another memorable premiership, as they did in 2014. That day, Russell enjoyed one of the finest moments of his football career as stand-in skipper for injured co-captains Nick Lower and Lukas Markovic.

"Your career highlight would be winning an AFL flag, but to win one in probably the second-best competition in Australia and being default captain was an amazing feeling," Russell said.

"For me individually, it was amazing to be down about my AFL career being over but then come to a really good club and get that success straight up.

"I'm already looking forward to the 10-year reunion in eight and a half years."

Dolphins break through... finally

It had been a long wait for the first win of Patrick Hill's senior coaching career in the Peter Jackson VFL but his Frankston troops delivered a break-through triumph on Saturday.

Hill had coached the Dolphins in 20 consecutive losses since the start of the 2015 season, but Frankston's 13-point comeback victory over Richmond at Frankston Oval ended the drought.

After suffering a 144-point defeat at the hands of the Casey Scorpions in Round 1, the Dolphins rebounded with a spirited performance in a 38-point loss to Werribee in Round 2. Hill further fuelled belief in his players against the Tigers though, as they recovered from a 29-point deficit at quarter time to steamroll their opponents in the final term.

Frankston's last win was in Round 16, 2014, a time when Hill was an assistant coach under Marco Bello at the Box Hill Hawks. That day, it knocked off Collingwood by 17 points at Frankston Oval, with current Sydney rookie Nic Newman the team's best player and former captain Shane Hockey also influential.

After 24 straight subsequent losses, it was the likes of off-season recruits Michael Sikora in the ruck and Andrew McInnes in defence, and goalkickers Nathan Gardiner (four majors) and Brandon Wood (three) who helped spur the Dolphins to victory this time around.

Another influential player was reigning dual best and fairest winner Ben Cavarra. At just 20 years of age, the 175cm midfielder stood in as captain for the suspended Jason Pongracic and can now add another line to an impressive CV that also includes the 2013 Morrish Medal and two best and fairest awards while at the Eastern Ranges, as well as the best-on-ground medal while captain in the club's 2013 TAC Cup premiership triumph.

After three rounds of VFL Women's action, Melbourne Uni, Darebin Falcons and Eastern Devils all remain undefeated.

The MUGARS now top the ladder in VFL Women's, with some percentage-boosting wins to start the season.

Their latest win was by 109 points against Cranbourne, with Emma Kearney, Gabriella Pound and Jess Anderson all kicking three goals. They have an average winning margin of 116 points to start the year, but have faced three of the four former Division 1 teams in Seaford, Knox and Cranbourne.

This weekend Melbourne Uni faces its first real test of the season against Eastern Devils, with the Devils enjoying a 185-point win over Knox last round. Sarah Perkins (six goals), Peppa Randall (five) and Jaimee Lambert (four) were the key destroyers up forward for the Devils.

St Kilda fought off a persistent VU Western Spurs to claim a win on the road and stay within striking distance of the top four. The Sharks kicked six late goals to blow the margin out to 32 points after a close contest all afternoon.

In the final game, a four goal to nil second term helped Diamond Creek set up a 55-point win over Geelong, with the Creekers moving to fourth spot on the ladder, just 13 percent ahead of St Kilda in fifth.

Round 4 Highlights

The Eastern Ranges and Geelong Falcons have set up a significant clash at Avalon Airport Oval this Saturday after both teams recorded big wins in Round 4.

The **Ranges** gave an injury-depleted **Tasmania** a rude introduction to TAC Cup football in 2016, defeating the Mariners by 81 points at Box Hill City Oval on the back of an 11-goal-to-three first half.

The **Falcons**, meanwhile, proved too strong for the **Northern Knights** at Simonds Stadium, breaking free of their pesky opponents in the final quarter by booting a massive 10.6 to Northern's two goals to record a 67-point victory.

Both Eastern and Geelong now hold records of 3-1 and, positioned in 5th and 6th on the ladder respectively, enter what could prove to be an 'eight-point game' come the end of the home-and-away season.

The teams met in last year's finals series, with the Ranges upstaging the Falcons in a semi final by 54 points en route to the Grand Final. This weekend's result could have a significant bearing on when exactly these likely top-eight teams clash in September this year.

Last season's minor premiers the **North Ballarat Rebels** haven't found the going as easy in 2016, finally notching their first win against the **Calder Cannons** at Rams Arena on the weekend.

The 59-point triumph was head coach Gerard FitzGerald's first of his new tenure at the Rebels (he also coached the club in 2005-06), with his charges piling on 10 goals to three after half time to keep Calder's winless start to the season going.

Also still winless in 2016 is the **Gippsland Power**, which couldn't match the undefeated top-of-the-table **Murray Bushrangers** at Ikon Park.

Gippsland was behind the eight-ball from the start, conceding a 21-point advantage to the Bushrangers by quarter time which extended to a 33-point margin at the final siren.

Just behind Murray on the ladder are the much-improved **Sandringham Dragons**. After a ninth-placed finish in 2015 (six wins and a draw), the Dragons already have four wins on the board this

year after accounting for the **Northern Territory** in the state's first TAC Cup game of 2016 by 73 points at Trevor Barker Beach Oval.

The **Dandenong Stingrays** are still undefeated in third position following an entertaining victory over a gallant **NSW/ACT Rams** outfit at Frankston Oval. The Stingrays looked to have killed off NSW/ACT's chances several times in the second half, but the Rams always seemed to find a way to answer and eventually only succumbed by 15 points.

The **Oakleigh Chargers** occupy fourth spot on the ladder after winning a second consecutive Friday night match, this time against the **Bendigo Pioneers** at Queen Elizabeth Oval. Despite leading by 26 points at the last change, Oakleigh's late inaccuracy (kicking just five behinds in the final term) kept the Pioneers in it, but Bendigo couldn't bridge the gap and ultimately went down by 13 points.

In Round 4's other match, the **Western Jets** lost their third straight game, falling to **Queensland** by 28 points in hot and sunny Aspley.

QLD, NSW/ACT bow out for 2016

Queensland and the NSW/ACT Rams have bowed out of the TAC Cup for 2016 with mixed results, and the next time their players will face off against Victorian opposition will be at June's NAB AFL U18 Championships.

Queensland leaves with two wins from two games, accounting for the Northern Knights by 17 points at Preston City Oval in Round 3 and the Western Jets by 28 points at home in Aspley last Saturday.

The NSW/ACT Rams just held on in the last quarter to defeat the surging Calder Cannons by six points at Rams Arena in Round 3, while they lost an entertaining battle with the Dandenong Stingrays by 15 points at Frankston Oval on Saturday.

The Rams played seven TAC Cup games in 2015, notching five wins – including victories over eventual grand finalists the Oakleigh Chargers and Eastern Ranges. Queensland recorded two wins last year, also including one against the premiership-winning Chargers.

The interstate teams (including Tasmania and the Northern Territory, which play their second and final TAC Cup games this weekend) won't play as many TAC Cup games in 2016 due to the Division 2 section of the U18 Championships being staged earlier than usual in May.

This will allow an Allies team comprising the best talent from the four interstate teams to be selected based on those games, which will then compete against Vic Country, Vic Metro, South Australia and Western Australia in Division 1 of the U18 Championships during June.

Fitz's first win... sort of

North Ballarat Rebels head coach Gerard FitzGerald led his charges to the first victory of his new tenure when they defeated the Calder Cannons by 59 points at Rams Arena last Saturday.

But it wasn't actually FitzGerald's first win as a Rebels head coach.

The legendary North Ballarat Roosters VFL coach took the reins at the Rebels in 2005 and 2006, when he led them to second and first-placed finishes after the respective home-and-away seasons.

The triple-premiership-winning Roosters mentor is the VFA/VFL record holder for most games coached with 345 and returned to the TAC Cup this year after being replaced in his VFL role by former club champion Marc Greig.

Plenty on line in Rd 5

Some interesting match-ups in Round 5 will tell us a lot more about how several TAC Cup teams are placed in the scheme of things in 2016.

The top two teams on the ladder will meet on Sunday, with the Murray Bushrangers (1st, 4-0) hosting the Sandringham Dragons (2nd, 4-1) at Wangaratta Showgrounds. Another two highly rated outfits will clash at Avalon Airport Oval on Saturday, with the Geelong Falcons (6th, 3-1) facing the team that knocked them out of last year's finals, the Eastern Ranges (5th, 3-1).

At the other end of the table, two winless teams – the Gippsland Power and Calder Cannons – will be desperate to get on the board in 2016 at Morwell Recreation Reserve on Saturday, as will the TAC Cup's other two winless outfits the Northern Knights and Tasmania, who meet at Preston City Oval on Sunday.

Dandy defies numbers to rip Rams

The Dandenong Stingrays managed to prevail over the NSW/ACT Rams in one of last week's most memorable TAC Cup games despite trailing in a number of areas on the stats sheet.

The Stingrays defeated the Rams by 15 points at Frankston Oval despite losing the counts for disposals, marks, contested possessions and clearances by significant margins.

With two players down on the interchange bench, Dandenong was headed by NSW/ACT for the first time midway through the last quarter. (Callum White (hamstring) and Mason De Wit (finger) had suffered game-ending injuries early in the match.)

The fact the Stingrays recovered from losing their lead with the weight of statistical numbers against them and limited available rotations from the bench speaks volumes of their ability to make the most of opportunities.

The Rams didn't let them have many though, winning 35 more contested possessions and 10 more clearances and subsequently enjoying 108 more disposals and 24 more uncontested marks than the Stingrays.

In spite of these numbers, Dandenong drove the ball inside its forward 50 arc six more times than its opponent. While NSW/ACT controlled the ball methodically, the Stingrays moved it quickly into a forward line that has proved dangerous all season.

Their main ball-winners in the middle were Nathan Scagliarini (19 disposals, seven clearances, four inside-50s), Tom Glen (25 disposals, five clearances, three inside-50s) and Max Kleverkamp (20 disposals, six clearances).

They did a lot of the work that allowed 169cm Sam Fowler to kick five goals and 192cm Josh Battle to boot four, with both forwards contributing majors in the crucial period of the final term after the Rams hit the front by a point.

The Stingrays slotted five goals straight after that moment to seal the match and did so with just 56 total fourth-quarter disposals – 24 less than NSW/ACT, which only put four majors on the board in the final stanza.

A goal every 11.2 disposals: If you can hit the scoreboard with such potency, it usually won't even matter how much of the ball your opposition gets.

A central factor in Frankston's first win since Round 16, 2014 was its uncompromising approach without the ball. The Dolphins had 13 more tackles than Richmond last weekend despite also having 15 more disposals than the Tigers. Stand-in captain Ben Cavarra, Andrew McInnes and Jayden Cass led the defensive effort with seven tackles each.

Lachlan Huppatz was a key to the North Ballarat Rebels securing their first win of 2016 against the Calder Cannons. The 178cm endurance machine had a clear game-high 20 uncontested possessions to help rip the Cannons apart in space. Huppatz showcased his running ability at the TAC Cup fitness testing day in March, recording an elite beep test result of 16.02.

Footscray had two more scoring shots than Sandringham on Saturday, but still lost to the Zebras by 28 points. The Bulldogs kicked just 12 goals from 65 entries inside their forward 50 while Sandy bagged 17 majors from 61 entries. Small forward Josh Grabowski was one of the main offenders for the vanquished, managing only an inaccurate 2.4.

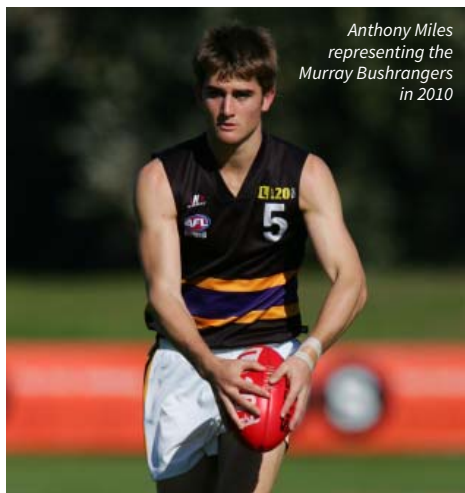

Miles taken to 50 games

Former Murray Bushrangers midfielder Anthony Miles played his 50th AFL match in Richmond's 33-point loss to Melbourne in Round 5.

Miles, 24, returned on Sunday night after being left out of the previous week's team and had 25 disposals, seven tackles, six clearances and kicked a goal against the Demons.

The Howlong junior originally joined GWS as a NSW/ACT zone selection in 2011 after being named in the 2010 TAC Cup Team of the Year. He played 10 games over two seasons with the Giants before being delisted and then selected by Richmond at pick no.27 in the 2013 Rookie Draft.

Miles transformed the stoppage-winning ability of the Tigers midfield upon being called into the senior team in mid-2014. He has since played 40 games for the club and established himself as a reliable performer in contests.

Papley's star rises as Darcy debuts

Former Gippsland Power small forward Tom Papley was named the NAB AFL Rising Star nomination for Round 5 after a dynamic performance in Sydney's 39-point win against West Coast.

Papley, 19, revelled in wet conditions at the SCG on Saturday with 20 disposals, eight marks, six inside-50s, four tackles and two goals.

The 176cm Bunyip junior has been a revelation since being selected by the Swans with pick no.14 in last year's Rookie Draft. He was elevated to the club's primary list before Round 1 and has played all five games in 2016, booting eight goals and averaging 13 disposals, three marks and three tackles per game.

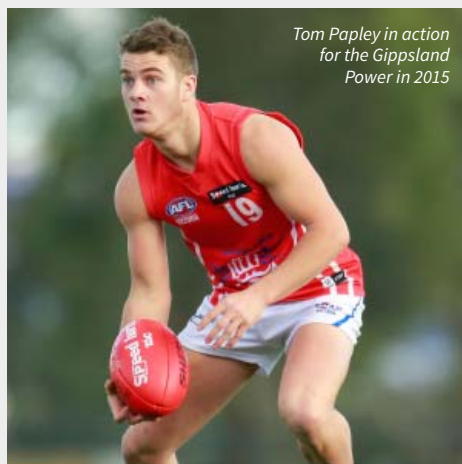
Papley starred as an over-age player for Gippsland in 2015, kicking 33 goals in 15 matches and averaging 16 disposals, four marks and three tackles per game during the home-and-away season. He also booted five goals in three matches as a 23rd player for the Casey Scorpions VFL team last year.

The Horsham junior was selected with pick no.27 in the 2015 NAB AFL Draft after earning selection on the interchange in last year's TAC Cup Team of the Year. However, he arguably had a better season in 2014 when named in defence in the U18 All Australian team following a stellar NAB AFL U18 Championships campaign for Vic Country.

Vics ready to rumble at National Championships

Victoria is ready to stamp its authority on the 2016 AFL Youth Girls National Championships next week, following the announcement of the Victoria Metro and Victoria Country Youth Girls squads.

The 27-player squads bring together talent from all corners of Victoria, including representatives from 10 different AFL Victoria Country Region Commissions and nine metropolitan community football leagues.

Of the 27 players selected in the Vic Country squad, AFL South East has the most representatives with seven players, followed by AFL Barwon with six and three each from AFL Gippsland and AFL Goulburn Murray.

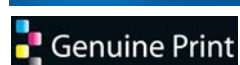
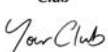
