The game was there to be won in the last but we needed to lift if we were going to win it. Doug kept us in the game with a number of last line defensive efforts which limited their scoring and Robert had an important period, being thrown on the ball to cover one of our midfielders, to keep them from going inside their 50.

and we went behind. Duncan was able to get off his player from half back to push forward and kick the goal that gave us back the lead which we held for the rest of the game.
