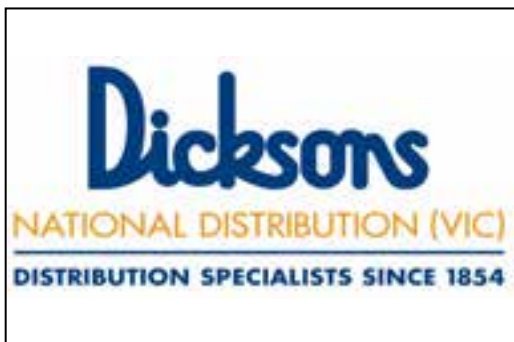

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AFL COMMUNITY UMPIRING ROUND

THE 2016 season marks the first time in over a decade in which we have more Division One field umpires capable of umpiring at the highest level in our league to select from in Round One.

This is largely due to the development of younger umpires through the umpiring academies which commenced in 2009.

Fourteen of the current 24 umpires have come through this development program.

This group does not include Greg Denison and Adrian O'Donnell, who are not in the 2016 group due to injury and work commitments respectively.

The duo are clearly the best two umpires over the past three years, and in Adrian's case, the best ever WRFL field umpire.

Like football teams we need to develop our juniors and provide an environment in which they enjoy umpiring, feel supported and have the opportunity to be the best they can be.

In the junior grades we now provide field umpires to majority of games, again supported at the Under-9 and Under-10 level with senior mentor umpires who are on the ground with the younger umpires to provide support and guidance, just like football coaches.

The added age group in juniors in 2016 has required more umpires, but even with an increase in number of umpires we will find it difficult to cover every junior game every week.

The long term aim is to achieve the goal of parents not having to umpire games instead they can enjoy watching their children play.

The community is very supportive of the WRFL umpires, however it only takes one or two individuals to create issues which are not in line with the WRFL expectations in relation to player and coach conduct.

Whilst it is great to be passionate about our clubs, players, etc., we need to consider the level of experience that the umpire has when you decide to judge.

Have a think about, your position in seeing a free kick versus the umpire's position.

Generally from a field umpire's perspective we are on the opposite side of the contest to the spectator.

The goal umpire is normally under the flight of the ball where a spectator maybe 50m away with a different angle or view.

Sometimes it is good to step back and think before we react. We are all role models.

Whilst this week there will be a focus on umpires, we would like this week to be seen as just another week, in the WRFL it is business as usual.

One key aspect we focus on with all our umpires is being in the correct position.

Field umpires need to be 20-25m side on from the contest, boundary umpires along the boundary line, away from the players, and goal umpires under the flight of the ball or on the goal line.

It is great to get around to the different grounds and inevitably I end up having a discussion with either spectators, club officials or players.

I really enjoy the opportunity to talk to each and every person and hopefully explain what has happened, and yes we get it wrong sometimes, but like players who get it wrong sometimes, we are always aiming to be the best we can be.

ASPIRING umpires from across metropolitan Melbourne have the chance to learn from some of the AFL's best umpires as part of the 2016 Mates program.

Michael Gurrie, Nicholas van Schoten and Murray Osborne were the trio selected from the Western Region Football League to take part in this annual initiative.

The youngsters were teamed with AFL Umpire Troy Pannell.

Pannell, a senior AFL umpire, will meet with the WRFL umpires on four or five occasions this year as well as speak regularly about the different areas of umpiring.

Gurrie said he was looking forward to working with Pannell.

The talented young umpire said he first got into umpiring a couple of years ago.

"I played football for several years, after a while realised the game wasn't suiting me physically, but I still wanted to be involved," he said.

Gurrie said his overall goal as an umpire was to officiate a Division 1 seniors match, but said his main focus at the moment was to continue to improve.

AFL Umpire Coach Hayden Kennedy said the 'Mate's Program' was a great chance for not just community umpires, but AFL umpires as well.

"I had the opportunity to be involved in this mentor program a few years ago and it's a great experience to be a part of," he said.

WRFL YOUNGSTERS READY TO FIRE AGAINST BFNL

WRFL Under-19 coach Matt Dean is excited with the talent he will unleash at Ballarat in the upcoming Interleague clash.

Dean and his coaching panel have announced a 35-man squad for the WorkSafe AFL Victoria Community Championships after having over 50 players at the initial training sessions over the past fortnight.

Those players who didn't make the final 35 are welcome to contact the WRFL Office to seek feedback from the Under-19 coaching team.

Eleven clubs from across the league are represented in the squad, with Spotswood leading the way with seven players named.

Dean said the amount of interest from players to be involved on the day had been overwhelming.

"We have had a fair bit of talent to choose from and all the players have been really keen to get involved, which is what we want," he said.

"I was nervous before the first training session, but all the players and the coaches have embraced this challenge.

"Before training we spoke about the importance of this game and they have all bought in, which is exciting.

"We, as a team, are really wanting to put our best foot forward."

The Ballarat Football Netball League has also released an extended squad ahead of the May 21 match.

A total of 60 players were picked in Ballarat's initial squad, with 11 BFNL senior clubs represented.

The talented youngsters have been training over the past few weeks, with Ballarat coaches expected to cut that list to just 23, closer to the Community

Championship match.

The WRFL will take on Ballarat at Whitten Oval on May 21. The Under-19 match will be played at 11.45am and the Senior match is at 2.30pm.

UNRELENTING ATTACK GIVES HOPPERS BIG WIN

HOPPERS Crossing kept its place on top of the ladder with a thumping 137-point win over Wyndhamvale.

An unrelenting attack was the key to the result, as the Warriors had 14 individual goal kickers, five of those players booting at least two.

The 21.20. (146) to 1.3. (9) final score line truly shows how dominant Hoppers are and also sends a warning to all other Division 1 Reserves clubs that when on song, they can run wild.

Wyndhamvale would be thoroughly disappointed with its effort, as the side offered no resistance or fight over the course of four quarters.

The Falcons could only manage one goal for the match, and were kept scoreless in two of the four quarters.

On Saturday, the Warriors face fellow top four side Sunshine, while both Wyndhamvale and Spotswood will aim to win their first game of the season when they also go head-to-head.

Seven goals in the final term saw what was a close game, turn into a 57-point win for Sunshine.

Although St. Albans jumped out to a quarter time lead of 25-points, the game was close all afternoon until the final term, as neither side was able to wrestle control from the other.

As such, the game was up for grabs heading into the fourth with Sunshine ahead by just eight points.

The game flipped on its head in the fourth as the Kangaroos held the Saints scoreless, while booting seven of their own goals. It was a ferocious example of what the Roos can do when at its peak.

St. Albans will look to bounce back against Albion and even its record to 3-3.

The WRFL umpires who are going to be part of the various training sessions are Jacob Spinks, Flynn Dalton, Kai Abela, Ebony Dodemaide, Darcy Kirkpatrick and Adam Steger.

Hopefully all the WRFL umpires enjoy the visit by the AFL umpires to Scovell Reserve.

LAWS OF THE GAME – QUIZ #5

Last week's question:

Team A has just scored a behind and an opposition player is preparing to kick the ball back into play. A player from Team A is standing within one metre of the goal square. 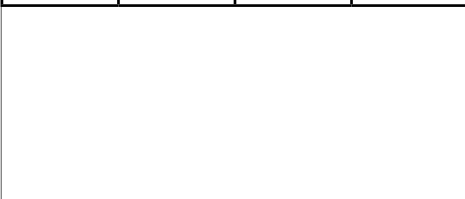
