

VicRoads Club Permit (Red Plate) Scheme
Agreement with Maffra Sale Motorcycle Club Inc.

The motorcycle detailed below is an eligible vehicle under the VicRoads Club Permit Scheme, having been manufactured more than 25 years prior to the date of application, having not been modified to any significant degree, and, after receipt of the permit, will not be modified to any significant degree.

As detailed below, I hereby notify M.S.M.C. of the Club Permit Number, and expiry date, allocated to the vehicle by VicRoads.

I accept full responsibility for maintaining the motorcycle in a roadworthy condition, whilst permitted through the M.S.M.C.

I will notify the M.S.M.C., in writing, if I sell, or dispose of the vehicle in any way.

I will notify the M.S.M.C., in writing, should there be any change to the vehicle, or personal, details submitted to VicRoads.

I will maintain financial membership of the M.S.M.C., and agree to pay an Administration Fee, currently \$10, for each vehicle permit, registered or renewed, through the M.S.M.C.

I will carry the Log Book with the vehicle, at all times the vehicle is in use on the roads, and will complete the Log Book each day of use, as required by VicRoads.

I will not use a vehicle permitted through the M.S.M.C. for any commercial purpose.

I accept that the M.S.M.C. is under no obligation to approve a permit registration, or renewal application, if, in the M.S.M.C.'s opinion, any of the permit conditions have been breached.
