

After the cancellation of training due to the Severe Weather Warning, the weather again smiled on Glenunga Yellow with our home game versus a Lockleys side with a few tall timber players. It was clear from the start that Lockleys were well organised and had turned up for a good game with goals evenly spread between the sides in the first half. After a slow start, our forward line took advantage of the strong midfield play from Hugo, Talan and Harrison which resulted in a couple of goals to Josh.

The second quarter played out in a similar way to the first with goals back and forth between both sides. Hugo was continuing to take high marks and kicked a goal from a long way out. Talan has really improved his running toward the goals and deserved the great goals he kicked. Lockleys used their tall players to get hold of the ball and the game was still evenly poised at half time. The midfield and defence which included Ethan, Will, Hudson, Talan, Harry G and Josh did a great job keeping the Lockleys team goalless although a couple were disallowed as they were kicked by a midfielder from the wrong zone.



The boys in the last quarter started to take control of the game with some strong attack on the ball, good running and excellent vision to find their teammate via foot or hand. Will T added to our goal tally with a lovely snap and Hudson and Ethan provided good forward pressure. Josh, Harry G and Talan battled hard in the midfield and Hugo was a formidable wall in the defence marking everything in sight and finding his teammates with excellent efficiency.

Coach Justin was extremely pleased with the efforts of the boys against quality opposition. Good team play, attack on the ball and efficiency to goal was evident over the whole four quarters. Thrilling to be able to report we achieved a couple Coast to Coast goals that started in the back line and through foot and hand, we took it the length of the oval for goals.
