

9 Uniforms

Each player must play in the correct Marcellin Eagles Uniform which consists of:

- A Marcellin Eagles maroon basketball singlet with blue shoulder region, yellow trim, white numbers and Marcellin Eagles insignia, and
- Marcellin Eagles maroon shorts with blue and yellow trim; the shorts must not have pockets.
- Marcellin Eagles hoodies and training tops are also available however this is optional.
- Marcellin Eagles sports bags are also optional.

Each child must play with a different number. Singlet numbers can include 0 to 99. When a singlet does not have a number (or turned inside out) it should be recorded as double zero "00". **All new players must liaise with the Boys or Girls Co-ordinators for a number allocation prior to purchasing a uniform.**

No jewellery, plastic headbands, false nails or charity bands are to be worn during play. Hair should be tied back and no plaits are allowed.

Spare uniforms are kept at the Marcellin stadium. These are available as spares for fill in players and new registrations. One new uniform of each size is generally kept at the Marcellin stadium in case of a number clash within a team. An 'on loan' uniform register is maintained at the Club so that the Boys and Girls Team Co-ordinators and Venue Manager/Referee Co-ordinators can keep track of all stock. All borrowed uniforms must be signed out on the register and signed back in when returned to the Club.

Occasionally a Marcellin team will be fixtured to play another Marcellin team. In this case clash singlets are kept at the Marcellin stadium. The Coach or Team Manager will ensure that the clash singlets are available before the game by liaison with the Venue Manager/Referee Co-ordinator. The Venue Manager/Referee Co-ordinator is responsible for ensuring that clash singlets are returned and cleaned ready for use.

Uniform Supplier

Basketball Outlet in Smith Street Collingwood supply uniforms for the Club. Once you have been allocated a singlet number by your Boys or Girls Team Co-ordinator, contact Basketball Outlet to check if they have the uniform size and the number required.

At the time of printing the cost of a uniform is approximately:

- Singlet & Shorts & Number - \$70.00
- Singlet & Number - \$35.00
- Shorts - \$35.00
