life. On records available it has won the most premierships since the last war and, together with Rockbank, holds the record for the most consecutive premierships wins.

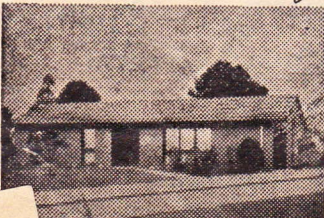

Wes Richardson played in the 1959 grand final, left to coach various major league teams and later became a legend in the Wimmera League as captain-coach of Nhill.
