# MATCH REPORTS

## U13 Round 10 – Wilston Grange White

Our first game after the mid year holidays was away again to Wilston Grange. It looked a good day for footy but we were down on numbers this week and expected to be stretched by the top of the table Gorillas.

We started well, with strong tackling and efforts to win the loose footy which gave us first use of the ball. Jacob was great all game, tackling hard from the outset and winning possessions from the first bounce. Korbin provided a good target up forward, attacking the ball well and Sam's great smothering and strong running helped us create scoring chances. Down back, James M defence was good, showing great anticipation for the ball to help us rebound and allowing us to keep the Gorillas scoreless as we took a four point lead at quarter time.

Into the wind, we upped our effort in the second quarter, working together well and tackling hard. Ryan set the tone for the game, tackling strongly, running hard continually leading well and getting involved to help team mates win the ball. Will C had his best game so far applying some great tackles and contesting to rebound the ball. Jahli also contested hard up forward to create scoring chances, along with Atticus who was a good target until a heavy knock saw him subbed out. We narrowly missed the only goal chance for the quarter but again held them scoreless and doubled our lead.

Things tightened in the third quarter but we did not let up in our intensity. Our midfield worked hard, with Cameron running all game to lead as well as making some important support in defence while Grace's quick hands and clever ball use helped us continue to press forward. James A put his body on the line to win some important possession while Tom read the ball well of half back to cut off their attack.

We had to push Robert to centre half forward given our injuries and he provided a focal point leading

and contesting well. Rhys was freed up as they stacked their defence allowing him to run, tackle and provide great support to the midfield.

The Gorillas had an easy shot on goal as they managed to get over the back of our defence but the result typified the team's efforts as the pressure on the mark and goal line did not let them score at all and we went into the final change up by 9.

In the final quarter our efforts to date showed and the team were running on empty. We started with some good forward pressure with Alyssa contesting well, allowing Ethan to take a mark and kick the first goal for the game. Doug continued to work tirelessly in ruck but also provided good leadership to the team as he ran out of legs.

As we tired, our defence came under siege but hung on, with Luke playing an important role on the last line to pressure and stop scoring. The Gorillas got one goal but the team, on their last legs, fought to keep them from scoring more and were very happy when the final siren went.

It was a fantastic win for the team, particularly given we had none on the bench and went one down in the second quarter. The defensive pressure from the team was amazing and their work for each other was our best for the season. Everyone played an important part in the win, particularly Will C and James A whose efforts on the ball we fantastic and Ryan who was our best on ground.

The AFL aims to address the issue of vilification and discrimination at all levels of Australian Football through the AFL Vilification and Discrimination Policy, which states:

“No League Participant or Club Official shall engage in conduct which may reasonably be considered to incite hatred towards, contempt for, ridicule of or discrimination against a person or group of persons on the ground of their:

- Race;
- Religion;
- Gender;
- Colour;
- Sexual preference, orientation or identity; or
- Special ability or disability

It was great to see that majority of our youth players in attendance for this special education session. During the session the players were told the importance of reporting any instances of vilification that they may witness.
