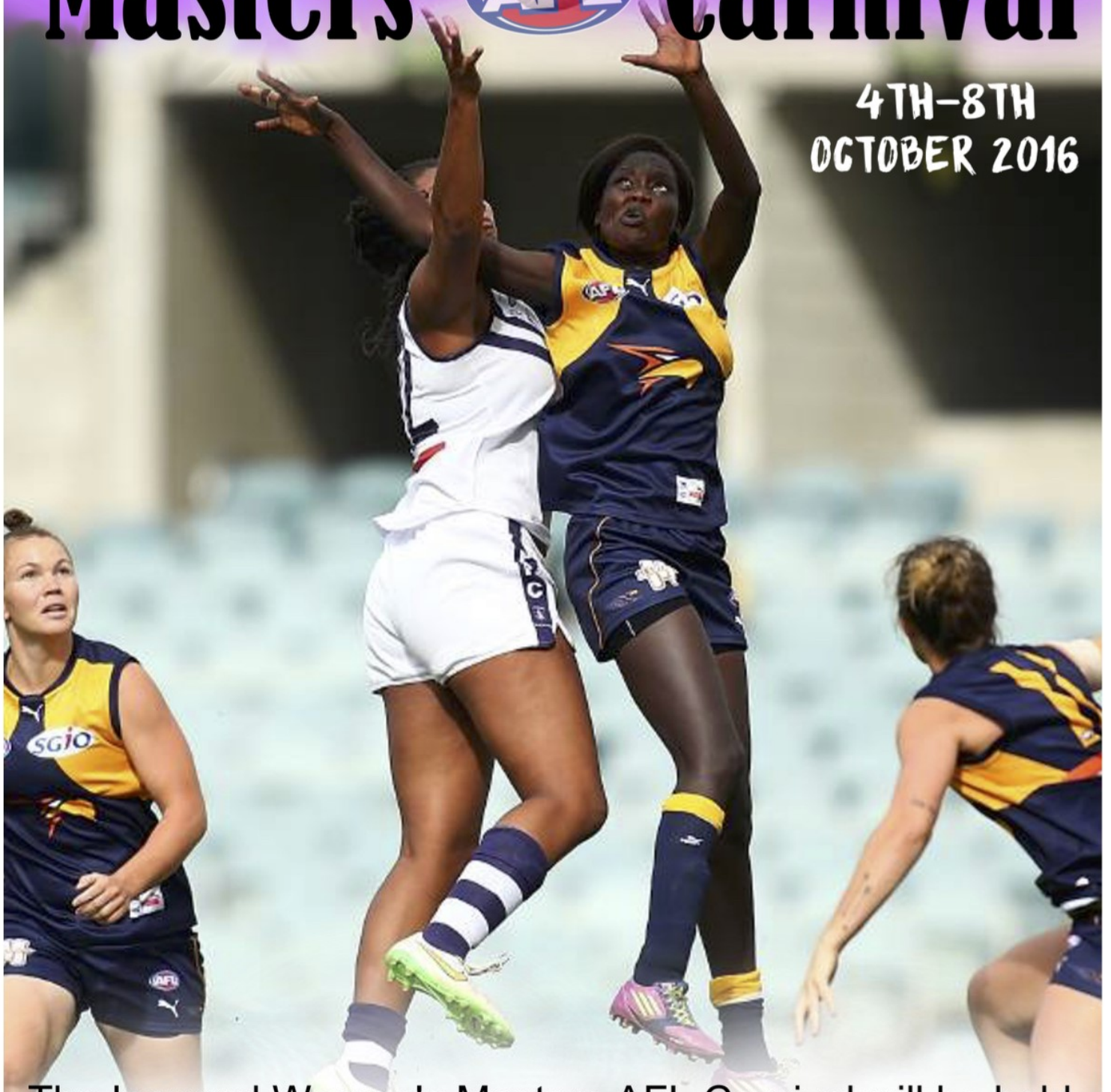

AFL Masters Women's Carnival Information

When	5th – 8th October, 2016	
Where	Gold Coast - Southport & Labrador ovals	
Eligibility	Masters games are open for players over 35 . However, in the inaugural year of the Women's Masters Carnival there will be an allowance of up to 5 players between 30-35 if extra players are required.	
Teams	Team nominations will be accepted from all Australian States. Nominations due 31st July.	
Games	There will be 3 games played over the four days of the carnival. Each game will be 40 minutes (4 x 10 minute quarters). Games will be played on Wednesday 5 th October, Friday 7 th October and Saturday 8 th October.	
Cost	Registration cost is \$275 per player. This includes the Presentation night & Hall of Fame function. For players not wanting to attend these functions the registration cost is \$125.

Further information

- Women's games will be scheduled together at the same ground to maximise participation and spectator numbers. Qualified Umpires will be provided and included in cost. Qualified trainers will be available at \$40 per team per game.
- All players and games will be administered through Sporting Pulse with live scoring. Professional team photos and player participation medals will be included in registration cost.
- All Australian Team and Best & Fairest winners will be announced at the Presentation night. Only players over 35 will be eligible for the All Australian team.
- Each state to be responsible for arranging player transport and accommodation. [All Sports Travel has been appointed the preferred travel service provider for the Mens Masters AFL Carnival and can group booking rates for group travel and a variety of accommodation packages. - Each state will be responsible for their team selection process, uniforms, managers & coaches. Additional support may also be offered by each state's Men's Masters Associations.
- Courtesy buses will be running between both grounds. Southport AFL is within walking distance to the GC light rail and Labrador AFL will have a courtesy bus running to the nearest station = easy access to and from the grounds. There is also free parking at both grounds.
- Hall of Fame function at Southport AFL on 6th October included in registration cost (includes drinks and finger food).
- Presentation function/ party will be held at Sea World (4 hours - dinner, drinks, band, show, rides, and games) on Saturday 8th October. The cost is included in full registration. Sea World has been hired out for the night and expected number will be around 1,200.
