| Overview of Role | <p>The Assistant Coach's primary responsibility is to support the Head Coach and other staff in the development and implementation of the coaching program, in line with the program's philosophy of developing great footballers and outstanding people. High level preparation will result in players understanding and having the ability to implement team structures in a pressured environment. Assistant Coaches will conduct all processes in a professional manner during their time in the role. Other key responsibilities include supporting the Head Coach as appropriate at training and on match days, and being proactive in contributing to the design and implementation of the programs' coaching curriculum.</p> <p>The aim of the program is to holistically develop young female footballers to the maximum of their ability, provide them with the knowledge to be able to perform at an elite level, to be able to cope with the rigours and expectations of playing at the highest level.</p> <p>Players are to be coached in such a way that develops players':</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Skills, physical attributes and football knowledge; • Psychological, emotional and physical wellbeing; • Confidence and belief in their abilities; and, • Personal character and leadership capacity. |

Key Accountabilities***Program Development:***

- Collaborate with Head and Assistant Coaches and support staff to develop a suitable coaching curriculum that will prepare players to play at the highest level, with a focus on the holistic development of each player.

Program Implementation:

- Implementation of the coaching curriculum, integrated with the Player Wellbeing and Strength and Conditioning programs.

Player Development & Wellbeing

- Support player development through a coordinated approach with other staff on the implementation of the coaching program and the cultivation of strong and positive relationships with players and their families. Support the implementation of the Player Wellbeing program.

Coaching Strategy

- Contribute to the development and implementation of a match day coaching strategy in consultation with other coaches, and other staff that is taught to players and implemented in matches. This will focus on both optimal team performance and the development of individual players' abilities.

Match Day Responsibilities

- Oversee line coaching duties on match days, which will include providing individual player feedback and comprehensive match reviews including a review of each game's vision.

Collaboration with Staffing Team

- Actively contribute to the delivery of the objectives of the program which includes participating in regular staff meetings, delivering coaching reviews of players and displaying a collaborative approach within their coaching style.

Talent Identification and Recruitment

- Assist in identifying talented footballers from U14 through to U18 Level who reside within the Eastern Ranges Talent region
