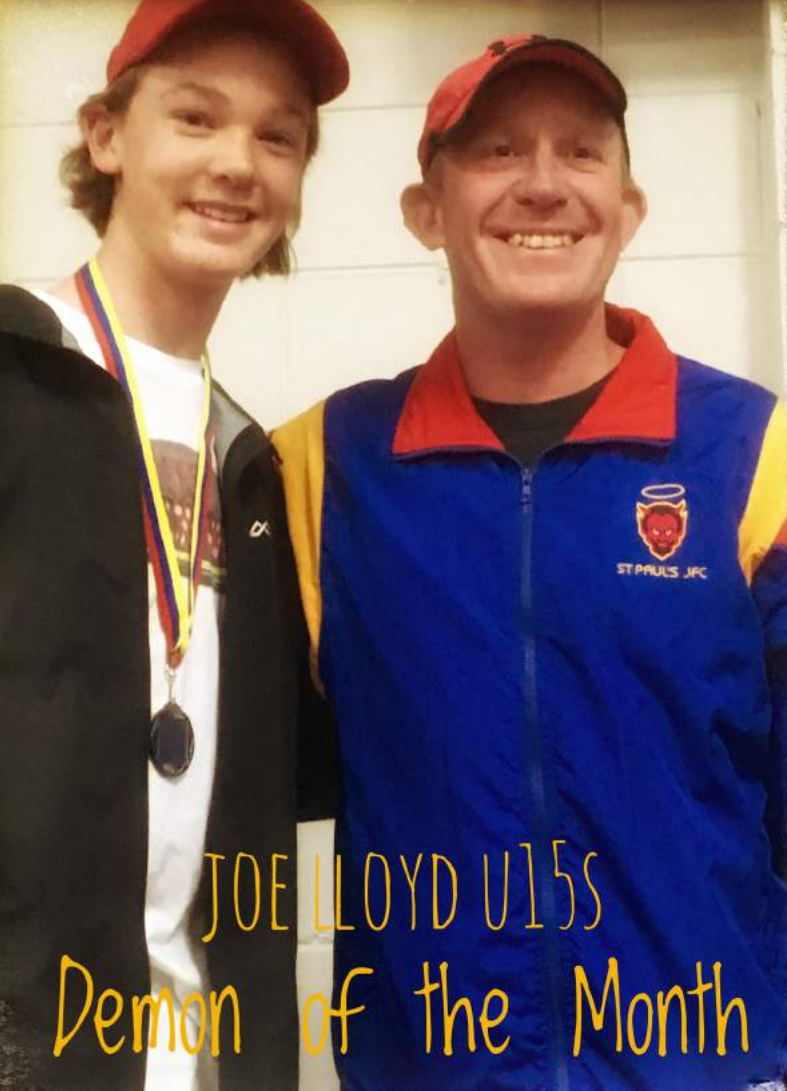
Lighting Carnival

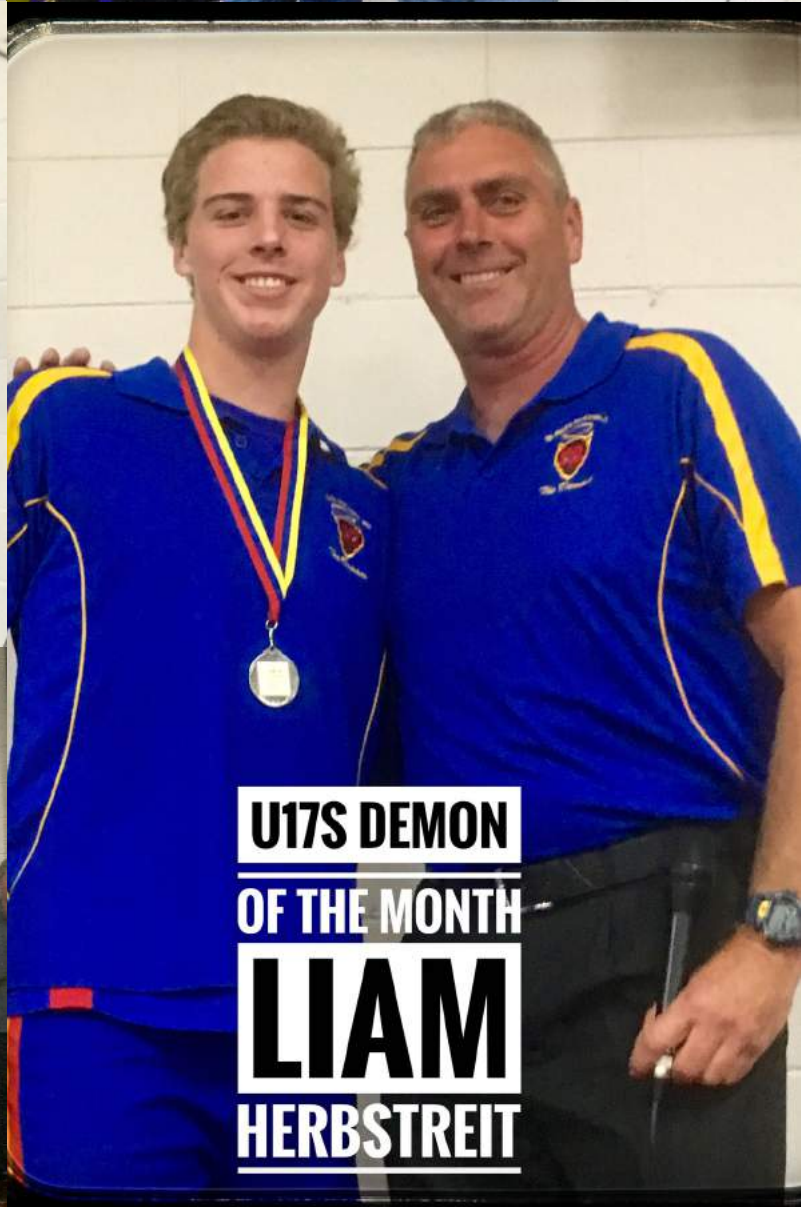
