U13 Round 16 – Springwood

Our final home and away game for the season was against Springwood at home this week. It was a milestone game for Ryan as he had recovered from illness to play his 100th game for the club. It was going to be tough for us though as Springwood's recent form suggested they were not the team we met in the wet mid season.

The first quarter we started slowly with our intent for the ball and tackling effort not up to our usual level. Jahli and Will continued their strong performances from last week though, contesting strongly for the ball while Tom tackled well as our defence came under pressure. The Puma's size and height troubled us and they led by a couple of goals at the break.

Our intensity lifted a little in the second with more inside 50s this quarter but we failed to convert our chances. Kyah attacked the ball well and James A put his head over the ball to win it across half back. Rhys making the tackle of the game on one of their big men, while Sam was at his running best and smothering multiple times in the same passage of play. Ryan read the play to save a certain goal running on to the loose ball to clear it but the Puma's were able to kick another 5 and take a strong lead to half time.

We came out as a different team after half time with greater intent, run and tackling.
