## MATCH RESULTS August 21

#### **TEAM COMPOSITES CONSTRUCTIONS - U12's Div 1**

St. Paul's McKinnon JFC 7.5-47 defeated Ajax 6.3-39 Goal Kickers: J Galgut 2. A Campbell 2, C. Rousakis 2, A. Chilcott Best Players: THE WHOLE TEAM

It was great to see so many familiar faces at Clayton on Sunday to help support us. Thank you. It had been a big season where we had surpassed our expectations many times. The Grand Final was in some ways, a celebration of where we had come from to be at the upper echelon of the best of the best in our year. Ajax are a very talented team who are extremely professional. We had beaten them in a great match at home by 4 points earlier in the season.

John's message to the boys beforehand was to play the game as if each quarter was a separate match. We lost the toss and were kicking to the non-scoring end against a slight breeze.

The Grand Final started at a hectic pace and like last week it took us a little while to get the flow. Our defence tried to endure Ajax'S initial barrage. Jasper Waldren got some early touches clearing our line. Declan Moore competed with great intensity. James Marotta was strong at the point of attack of the ball. Seamus O'Brien swept the ball into Noah Spitz who got the ball quickly into our forward line. The ball came over the pack and Alex Campbell swooped and passed it down Jordan Galgut's throat. Jordan, starting at full forward this week went back and kicked a tremendous goal to get us underway.

Ajax hit back hard. Their midfielders were winning the ball and moving it quickly. They put on 3 goals through some glorious high quality play. Sam Jones was the complete package; as tough as nails and unrelenting. He would do anything for his teammates. Just before quarter time, we put together some great play of our own. Jack Scherer kicked forward and the ball fell to Janko Hattingh who gave it off to Felix Dover who kicked the ball over the top and Jordan Galgut doubled back on the loose ball to slot a telling goal just before the siren. At quarter time, Ajax were a goal in front.

The second quarter started with Chris Rousakis working hard and starting to break the tag that he had. Sam Jones took some really telling marks on the half back line. Both teams were not giving an inch in a mammoth arm wrestle. We got the ball forward to Jordan Galgut who turned and kicked towards the goals and big Aidan Chilcott took a massive mark. On the same ground that his dad kicked his first ever senior goal some 34 years earlier, Aidan went back and booted an old fashioned Peter Hudson "flat punt" to convert under pressure and we had hit the front.

We were having a purple patch now and having hit the front, our midfield leaders took control for 10 minutes. Jack Behnk was fearless and intelligent. Chris Rousakis attacked the ball with amazing ferocity. Noah Spitz was brave and influential. The levels of our forward line pressure raised to the most intense levels and this manic aggression by Andrew Avramopoulos cleared a path for Yanni Tsoukalas who kicked to our big men in the goal square. The ball split to Alex Campbell who snapped and the ball seemed to take an eternity to come down, just inside the posts for a goal.

Our forward pressure now had Ajax panicking a bit and due to our extensively worked on structures; we got a turnover with Chris Rousakis marking one of Ajax's defensive kicks. Chris took off on his left foot, played on and slotted a great goal to give us a fourteen-point half time lead.

The third quarter was all Ajax with the breeze. We spent much of the quarter defending for our lives. Ajax kicked three quick goals and we were caught on the hop by their intensity levels. We battened down the hatches as the Ajax storm continued. Gabriel Patishman and Luke Healy kept working tirelessly. Louis Van Dame was moved on to Ajax's top goal scorer and quietened him down. Lucas Orso was moved to a run with roll with Ajax's best player. Just when it seemed Ajax would turn in front at three quarter time, we counter attacked. James Samuel passed the ball to Jack Scherer who kicked long to 20 metres out. Off the ensuring pack, Alex Campbell grabbed the ball and kicked a dribbler into the goal square, the ball bounced and kept bouncing end over end and just rolled over the line for a goal. As the three quarter time siren went, we found ourselves one point up.

The last quarter was some of the best underage football imaginable. With only a point or two the difference for ten minutes, both teams took the ball up and down the field. Kicking and switching needed to be inch perfect. The level of pressure was amazing as both sides threw themselves at the ball without any thought of danger or injury. Aidan Chilcott fought hard for every ball that came his way and put in some bone jarring tackles. Andrew Avandropolous implemented a level of intensity that was borderline manic. Janko Hattingh tried hard all day at the bottom of many packs. In the last 5 minutes, we set up a wall across our half forward line and no matter how they tried Ajax couldn't get out. Each boy taking their turn to commit to the ball and return into our forward line. Lucas Orso competed with tonnes of bravery and vigour. James Samuel was an absolute professional in the many times he propelled us forward. Seamus O'Brien gave us tremendous rebound off the half back line; the improvement in these guys during the season has been remarkable. Louis Vandame gave his all against taller opposition, offering nous and courage. Jack Scherer continued to hunt the ball all day. Finally, the pressure told as Noah Spitz got the ball down to Jack Behnk who kicked forward. Chris Rousakis got a whisker of an opening against a diving Ajax defence and kicked an amazing goal in the climax of the game. There was barely time for the ball to be bounced again before the final siren rang. The players came together to congratulate each other as the crowd was stunned at the brilliant spectacle that they had just witnessed.

Congratatulations to Ajax. You were wonderful. A magnificent game and a great season.

A shout out to all those parents who volunteered their time during games to take on roles and responsibilities. Thank you. The quality of the parents can be seen in the quality of their boys.

To Paddy Moore and David Behnk who worked tirelessly as assistant coach and runner. You are both indeed honoured gentlemen. Thank you.

To John Rousakis, you have been an amazing coach with an incredible knowledge of AFL football. Not only were you a champion player in your day, your ability to communicate and get the best out of young men is the best I have seen. Thank you for putting your heart and soul into our season.

We have come a long way this year and in fact over the last 3 years. We know that some teams haven't graded yet and we will have to get better to continue to be competitive with the very best in our age group.
