### Matt Dunn Report

#### **Kangaroos v North Warrnambool**

Coming up against North Warrnambool, we were aware of the task in front of us, but also wanting to play the game on our terms. We started well with Tom Feely leading the way across half-forward, kicking the first goal. The opening twenty minutes saw an even game of football,



until North broke away in the next ten minutes to hold an eighteen point lead at guarter time. We lost two of our stronger bodied players Hamish Waldron and Sam Hassell who clashed heads at the opening bounce, however the boys were able to stick with their opponents and produce an fairly tight quarter, North had more scoring shots, but our pressure was 'up' and we were playing attacking football. At the main break we went into the rooms trailing by 19 points, but with a belief that if we continued to pressure and tidy up our ball use, we could push the ladder leaders all the way. Unfortunately the Eagles size and strength started to wear us down; and despite our pressure, North Warrnambool showed why they are undefeated so far this season, with good ball use; and plenty of marking targets. At three quarter time the margin had blown out to 46 points. Going into the final term, we wanted to fight the game out, aiming to win the quarter. Our boys battled on manfully, with lots of effort and increased pressure. Although we used the ball more efficiently, North were still able to kick another eight goals to our three, taking the game by 75 points. But our boys can hold their heads high for the way they competed over the four quarters; and I don't think it was a true reflection on the evenness of the contest. While disappointed with another loss, I am pleased with the effort of the playing group against a side that has the size, skill and experience of the premiership favourite. Our average age again on the day was twenty. We had another teenage debutant in seventeen year old Dylan Godwin who got better as game went on. Jack Sutherland still only eighteen, gave away 2-3 inches and at least 20 plus kg, but rucked really well to give our mid-field an every opportunity at the stoppages, while Josh Muelendyks played his usual solid game, repelling many forward thrusts by North; and setting up our own attacks. The break last weekend came at a good time for us, allowing everyone to 'recharge' and 'freshen up'
