Home & Away Strips – Grand Finals

In each Grand Final, the Team listed first (i.e. as the "home team") is determined by the higher-placed team from the respective league. This team earns the right to wear its nominated home strip.

The team listed second (i.e. as the "away team") is determined by the lower-placed team, and this team must ensure it avoids a clash with the home team by wearing an appropriate away strip if necessary.

The below extract from section 3.5 from the 2016 Geelong Rules of Competition addresses what is permitted in regards to strip clashes as applicable to all Geelong competitions:

Playing Shirt: No Clash Permitted
Shorts: Clash Permitted
Socks: Clash Permitted

All GRFC Club delegates were sent a uniform list prior to the start of the season by FFV Geelong Regional Administrator Tonci Prusac. If your club is still unsure of what may constitute a clash leading into the weekend, the best practice for clubs is to bring multiple shirts and if needed change into the most suitable kit on the day. Player Rosters

For any Teams participating this weekend that have not done so already, clubs are reminded of their requirement to fill out the eligible player roster form. All players listed in these forms must be eligible to play for the respective Team as per Rule of Competition 6.4.1.:

6.4.1. Each Player must have played at least 5 Regular Season Competition Fixtures for their team during the current season in order to qualify to play Finals for that team in 2016.

The form is available <u>HERE</u> – please ensure you fill out the appropriate age group based on the league of that Team.

Teams without submitted player roster forms may be at risk of being eligible in line with Rule of Competition 6.4.1.

Host Club Support

Last year, supporters of several teams entered the premises of a finals host venue and began preparing and distributing hot food and beverages without consulting FFV or the host club.

We would like to make it clear to all supporters attending finals this weekend that the set up and operation of any cooking appliances outside the confines of the designated canteen is prohibited.

It must be acknowledged that clubs which volunteer to host finals are going to additional effort and expense to assist FFV and competing teams with a successful finals series. To help offset the costs absorbed during the finals, these clubs rely on revenue generated at their canteen. We ask all travelling supporters to keep this in mind and support our host clubs Surfside Waves SC and Barwon Heads SC this weekend.
