1. WELCOME

Meeting opened at 2014. The Chairman welcomed all in attendance and conducted the roll call.

2. AGENDA ITEMS:

a) BFA Sentencing & Guidelines

A revision has been completed and will be emailed out to all clubs shortly. The sentencing & guidelines will give you a clear view of why and what suspensions are handed down and what your avenues to appeal are. It is clear, transparent and fair.

b) Practice Matches

Contact the league if you are participating in practice matches so that we have a record of it so that you are covered for insurance and the organising of referees if needed.

c) Home for the Bayside League

Still in planning stages. Recently Wayne had a meeting with the local state member of parliament to discuss possibilities and processes. We now have further meetings with Frankston council

members to discuss further. We have members attending the Frankston council Soccer Liaison committee meeting tomorrow night also to further discuss options and the way ahead.

d) Referee Fees

Last delegates meeting we asked that all delegates take back to the club the proposal to raise the referee fee for all games from \$100 to \$110. All delegates present voted and the majority passed the proposal for the fee increase. This will entice more referees to the league and ensure we maintain a higher standard of referees. A bonus of \$20 is paid to referees upon completion of each game by the league if they tick all the boxes for paperwork, conduct, punctuality etc. If you or your club has a problem with a referee then you need to send in writing a report to the league as soon as this problem occurs – it will then be dealt with appropriately. Positive feedback is also strongly encouraged and assists the referee co-ordinator.

e) Presentation Night

Many venues were investigated but our date and/or the cost of the venue was not deemed suitable. The date is set for 17th of October 2015 and will again be held at the Frankston RSL. In the next couple of months we will be securing a venue further north so guaranteed next year it will be held at a venue that will be a little more central to those clubs further north. The date for next year's presentation will be 15th of October 2016.

f) Charity Day

To be held at Peninsula Strikers on 29th of March 2015. Games will be:

1100 – Peninsula Strikers Vs Seaford (Legends)

1300 – TOPSA Vs Bayswater (Women's)

1500 - Boronia Vs Endeavour

We request that all teams turn up and support this event. Practice matches should not be planned for this date so if you wish to have a practice match that weekend – make it on the Saturday.
