Introduction

Welcome to the 1996 Annual Presentation night. I would like to thank all the players and supporters who have been involved with the Penrith Australian Football Club for their efforts this year. This yearbook is our official record of the 1996 season and has been completed due to the tireless work of Mark Spooner. It reflects on a season that will be thought of as promising plenty but which ultimately failed to deliver. Initial indications from the quality and number of players at training were for the achievement of out Club's goals – to have all grades competing in the finals. Unfortunately, this was not the case.

Many clubs fall back on the adage that their injury toll was responsible for poor on-field performance. This was obviously the case with us this year. From our first grade list of thirty-one players, only nine played in our final game against South-West Sydney. This gives an indication of the strain on our playing strength. Having said that, all players who were required to move up showed determination and endeavour which did the club proud.

Whilst this year was disappointing, there were still many positives:

- First year players Wade Campbell, Tony Pianta, Guy Place, Shayne Stevens, Joe Marsters and Mark Steunenberg. All these players contributed greatly in their first year with the club.
- The Under 18s side competed in the Sydney Football League and showed great endeavour in this higher grade. They were able to be competitive with all clubs and won their fair share of games.
- The Under 18 players Nathan Hearnes, Clinton McDonald and Joe Conry who all tasted first grade and proved themselves capable of holding down their positions (usually after playing for the Under 18s). All of the other Under 18s who played in Reserve Grade showed great promise for the club's future.
- Our first grade coach Phil Putt, whose enthusiasm and commitment was severely tested during the year. Our disastrous injury toll certainly made it difficult for Phil. This, coupled with off field work dilemmas, showed that his character is beyond question. His ideas and energy have certainly benefited the club and with his involvement next year the club is looking forward to greater achievements.
- Amanda Waugh, who came to the club looking for work experience. Her eagerness and commitment was a welcome bonus this year. I hope the experience she received assists her in her future ambitions.
- The work of the committee has once again been tireless (and not without its share of dramas) and sees our club in a solid position for the future. I would like to personally thank Allan Tinker, David Nolan, Jason Ware, Craig Pusser, Trudi Tinker and Mark Spooner for all their efforts during the year.
- Finally, to all of the other people who helped out in some regard Pete Robinson and Daniel Barnes for running the boundary and all the people who helped in the canteen or on the sidelines.

So whilst not living up to expectations, this season has produced some positive results for our club in general. We need to build on these positives for next year and attempt to improve on our performance of the past two seasons. Hard work, dedication and planning will lead to a better club in the future.

Penrith Australian Football Club Inc. Life Member Alf Bradley

Alf was raised in Penrith and played his first season with the Rams in 1983. Previously he had played Rugby League, surfed a bit and dabbled in amateur boxing. He was convinced to have a go at Aussie Rules primarily for fitness. By 1985 he was an automatic selection in the club's First Grade side.

In 1987, in only his fifth season with the club, Alf won the First Grade Best & Fairest Award. His rucking skills and mobility have provided the club's running players with constant supply over the years and was a vital contribution to the club's two premierships in 1989 and 1991.

After calling it a day after the 1993 Grand Final he returned to the club in mid 1994 to fill the Reserve Grade coaching position which had become vacant. Whilst his commitment has waned slightly with the passing of time his achievement in winning the club's 1996 Reserve Grade Best & Fairest and Players' Player Awards is indication of the amazing natural ability in his possession.

Despite his awkward kicking style he has kicked 10 goals in one game (1990). It is also rumoured that Alf has an amazing turn of speed, usually without the hindrance of excess clothing! This profile would not be complete without recognizing his legendary TAB efforts and his consistent social contributions.

Penrith Australian Football Club Inc. Life Member Barry McLaughlin

Originally from Queensland, Barry was part of an RAAF family. During a four year posting in South Australia he had his first taste of Australian Football playing a season of juniors as a 12 year old. On moving to NSW he returned to his first love – Rugby League. His ability there took him to President's Cup level with Penrith in 1980 and 1981. A broken hand enforced a two month break from Rugby League so he joined the Rams with his brother Ken to keep fit.

For the next six years, 'Macca' played with the Rams on Saturdays and Rugby League with Cambridge Park on Sundays. This makes his achievements with the club even more remarkable. Playing a key role in his favourite centre position, Barry's efforts at the ball were tireless. His ruggedness and determination were always an amazement to his fellow players. This was indicated by his winning of the Players' Player award for three consecutive seasons (1989 – 1991). Barry was an integral part of the club's two premierships in three years.

Injuries and outside commitments restricted his playing involvement in 1992 and 1993, but he still accepted the Reserve Grade coaching position. His efforts in those years helped the club in often difficult circumstances. He returned again this season in Reserve Grade and again became a vital contributor for the team.

Off field 'Macca' has ben a long time punting pal of TAB Legend (?) Alf Bradley. His loyal support to the club's major sponsor saw him rewarded with the prestigious Pisspot of the Year Award in 1992.



Under 18 Grade Coach's Report

At the end of the 1995 season there were approximately 21 players leaving the junior ranks as they would be too old for Under 17s. With the juniors changing to even age groups, the NSWAFL commissioners decided that the upper age limit for juniors would be Under 16 years. The Junior Association decided to run an Under 18 competition as all junior clubs said they could field a side. Then the wheels started to fall off, with only four Junior clubs being able to field sides.

It wasn't until the end of February that we were informed there would be no Under 18 competition run by the Junior Association. Here we were at Penrith with 24 players, nowhere to play and less than six weeks to the start of the season. The only avenue open was to approach the NSWAFL to play in the SFL Under 18 competition (previously Under 19s). After four anxious weeks we received the nod. This gave us two weeks to prepare for our first game.

We realistically could not expect to reach great heights in our first season in the top Sydney competition. However, I thought we might be able to scrape into the finals given that we were very competitive during 1995 against Baulkham Hills, Pennant Hills and St Ives & Forest (who would form the basis of North Shore).

Our first game was against Baulkham Hills and we were in front at half-time. Only a poor third quarter cost us the game. The second round we came up against East Sydney, a game I thought we could win. However, with three State Under 16 players to help East Sydney out and our poor kicking at goal, the match ended as a draw.

Then work commitments, serious injuries and the attraction of Rugby League began affecting our playing strength. Suddenly we found we had to call more and more on the Under 16s to field a side. Attendance at training waned and our results started to worsen. However, even though this might sound like gloom and doom, I feel we had a remarkably good year for our first in the SFL. A strong core of committed players helped keep us going when things got tough. Five wins and a draw as well as fifth place our of eight teams is a good result, especially taking into account the uncertainty at the start of the season.

I do not want to single out individual players for praise because as far as I am concerned everyone who pulled on a jumper was equally important. However, I would like to thank Steve Balchin for acting as runner, Les McTegg for being Team Manager, Mike Cleary for goal umpiring and Jason Bradley for running the boundary (even when injured).

Finally the team would not have made it onto the paddock without the support and backing of Kevin McGee and the Junior Committee as well as the Seniors' Committee. Thank you for supporting my dream and getting a game of footy for these boys. I sincerely hope we can continue to field a team in the SFL Under 18 competition and who knows, it may not be long before we are joined by the Seniors' First and Reserve grades. Whatever happens it certainly bridges the gap between the Juniors and Seniors and augurs well for the future of Australian football in Penrith. I hope to see all the year's Under 18 players somewhere at Penrith next year.
