From the Vault

After winning the 19 would prove elusive between the wars. There was a losing Grand Final in 19 even finals appearances were rare for North Shore; which by then had become known as the Bears.

David Elliman won a Phelan Medal in 193 and Jack Guthrie in 1939; but through the depression years the club struggled for onfield success.

World War II broke out in the late 193 attitude towards football during the war effort had changed, and the game continued. As servicemen around the country were posted to Sydney, the game went through a strong period. The armed forces were a significant source of players; even at times fielding their own teams.

But not for North Shore, who went into recess in 19

opportunities available. As Japanese submarines entered Sydney Harbour, many thought that it could be the end of North Shore. But the club would return in 19 after the war was over.
