Filling out a Score Sheet

- 1. Fill in the FINAL score
- 2. Fill in the "Won By"
- 3. Ask the umpires to sign the forms
- 4. The umpires can then leave and go to their games

The scorers from both teams should fill in the rest of the sheet together.

- 5. Place a ✓ in the "Played" column next to the name of players that took the diamond TODAY.
- 6. Put the **FULL name of any newly registered players** in the section below and cross out the "Playing up" section
- 7. Put the **FULL name of any players "playing up"** and cross out the "New Registration"
- 8. Fill in any K2's and Home Runs both scorers should agree on these figures
- 9. Fill in the PROGRESSIVE Score. 1st base team is listed first.
- 10. If there are errors in the players name, players that are not in your team etc put a few words on the sheet that makes it very obvious what is happening. Abbreviations can be misinterpreted (and your abbreviations may not make sense to me)
- 11. Both scorers sign the form
- 12. Winning team should return the sheet

Score sheets filled out incorrectly just mean someone has to spend more time chasing up the corrections – and all of us have far better things to do. To encourage you to get it right we warn you the first time there is a mistake, you donate to the Cancer Council for any more.

Check the competition table on the notice board regularly – if you find a mistake drop a note explaining the problem in with the result sheet. Please don't wait until the end of the season. Thanks
