COACHES' CODE OF CONDUCT

- Be reasonable in your demands.
- Teach understanding and respect for the rules.
- Give all players a responsible amount of court time.
- Develop team respect for the ability of opponents including their coaches.
- Instil in your players respect for officials and an acceptance of their judgement.
- Guide your players in their interaction with parents and spectators.
- Ensure that equipment and facilities meet safety standards and are appropriate to the age and ability of players.
- Be prepared to lose sometimes.
- Remember your job is to develop players first, and win games second.



COACHES' CODE OF CONDUCT

- Act responsibly when players are ill or injured.
- As well as imparting knowledge and skills, promote desirable personal and social behaviour.
- Keep your knowledge current.
- Ensure that any physical contact with a player is appropriate.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person.
- Always respect the use of facilities and equipment.
- Teach your players all aspects of the game.
- Accept decisions of all referees as being final and called to the best of their ability.
